Patient Volumes

Medicaid Provider	Eligibility Requirement
Physicians (includes MDs and DOs)	30% patient volume
Nurse Practitioner	30% patient volume
Certified Nurse Midwife	30% patient volume
Dentist	30% patient volume
Providers in FQHCs and RHCs	30% patient volume
Pediatricians	Minimum of 20% patient volume

Peachcare for Kids™ members do not count toward the Medicaid patient volume criteria




Required Registration Information




Georgia Medicaid EHR Incentives Program registration begins late Summer 2011
