The mission of the Department of Community Health is to provide access to affordable, quality health care to Georgians through effective planning, purchasing, and oversight.





# Overview of SHBP

## Member Premiums



- Overall most commercial premiums have decreased over the past three years.\*
- MA Rates for the premium option have increased approx. three dollars over four years.
- MA Rates for the standard option have remained unchanged over four years.

\*Changes varied based on plan type/tier.



# SHBP Today

## Where Are We?

- Number of vendors has expanded.
- Plan options have increased.
- Rates overall have remained steady over past four years.
- Wellness credits transfer between options.
- Introduction of telemedicine, autism ABA benefit, and bariatric pilot.

# Direction for 2017

## Plan Designs and Options

- The vendors will remain the same:
  - UHC: HMO, HDHP, MA
  - BCBS: HMO, HRA
  - KP: Regional HMO
- The Plan designs will remain the same:
  - No changes to copays, co-insurance, deductibles.

# Direction for 2017

## Member Premiums

- Commercial premiums will see an overall increase of approximately 2.5% (although the increase/decrease will depend on option and tier).
- MA premiums will offer members a choice.
  - One option will remain the same while the other increases.
- These changes will help ensure the financial stability of the Plan.
