

### SSI Recipients

Aged, blind or disabled individuals who receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

Income Limits	Resource Limits
Individual - \$721 per month (\$8,652 per year) Couple - \$1,082 per month (\$12,984 per year)	Individual - \$2,000 Couple - \$3,000

### Nursing Homes

Aged, blind or disabled individuals who live in nursing homes and have low income and limited assets.

\$2,163 per month (\$25,956 per year)	Individual - \$2,000 Couple - \$3,000

### Community Care

Aged, blind or disabled individuals who need regular nursing care and personal services but can stay at home with special community care services.

Income Limits	Resource Limits

### Qualified Medicare Beneficiaries (QMB)

Aged, blind or disabled individuals who have Medicare Part A (hospital) insurance, and have income less than 100 percent of the federal poverty level and limited resources. Medicaid will pay the Medicare premiums (A&B), coinsurance and deductibles only.

### Hospice

Terminally ill individuals who are not expected to live more than six months may be eligible for coverage. Recipients must agree to receive hospice services through a Medicaid participating hospice care provider.

**Low-Income Medicaid (LIM)**

Parents/Caretakers with Dependent Child(ren) under age 19

Each additional person: \$50 per month (\$600 per year)

**Right from the Start Medicaid for Pregnant Women and their Infants  
(RSM Adults and Newborns)**

Pregnant women and their infants with family income at or below **220%** of the federal poverty level.

1	\$2,141 per month (\$25,692 per year)
2	\$2,885 per month (\$34,620 per year)
3	\$3,631 per month (\$43,572 per year)
4	\$4,374 per month (\$52,488 per year)

Each additional person: \$746 per month (\$8,952 per year)

**Right from the Start Medicaid (RSM Children) - 205 % FPL**

Children under 1 whose family income is at or below **205%** of the federal poverty level.

Family Size	Income Limits
1	\$1,995 per month (\$23,940 per year)
2	\$2,688 per month (\$32,256 per year)

3	\$3,383 per month (\$40,596 per year)
4	\$4,076 per month (\$48,912 per year)

Each additional family member: \$695 per month (\$8,340 per year)

**Right from the Start Medicaid (RSM Children) - 149% FPL**

Children 1 to 5 whose family income is at or below **149%** of the federal poverty level.

2	\$1,954 per month (\$23,448 per year)
3	\$2,459 per month (\$29,508 per year)
4	\$2,963 per month (\$35,556 per year)

Each additional family member; \$506 per month (\$6,072 per year)

**Right from the Start Medicaid (RSM Children) - 133% FPL**

Children 6 to 19 whose family income is at or below **133%** of the federal poverty level.

2	\$1,744 per month (\$20,928 per year)
3	\$2,195 per month (\$26,340 per year)
4	\$2,645 per month (\$31,740 per year)

Each additional family member; \$451 per month (\$5,412 per year)

**Medically Needy**

Pregnant women, children, aged, blind, and disabled individuals whose family income exceeds the established income limit may be eligible under the Medically Needy program. The Medically Needy program allows a person to use incurred/unpaid medical bills to "spend down" the difference between their income and the income limit to become eligible.
