

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to 42 C.F.R. § 447.205, the Georgia Department of Community Health is required to give public notice of any significant proposed change in its methods and standards for setting payment rates for services.

### HOSPITAL SERVICES

Act 4 of the 2017 Georgia General Assembly, known as the Hospital Medicaid Financing Program Act, continues the hospital provider fee program authorized under O.C.G.A. Title 31-8-179, which is scheduled to expire June 30, 2017. Therefore, pending CMS approval, effective for inpatient and outpatient hospital services provided between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2020, and subject to payment at fee-for-service rates, the Department is proposing to continue the current increased hospital inpatient and outpatient reimbursement rates. The increased reimbursement is necessary in order to recognize additional costs associated with the provider fees imposed by the Act. As required in the original program, Critical Access Hospitals, Public State Owned Hospitals, and Psychiatric Hospitals are exempt from the provisions of the Act.

The continuation of this Program is estimated to increase annual expenditures as follows:
