#### Review of Quarterly Transition Data (DCH, Sandy Taylor, Leslie Vaughns)

**Sandy Taylor** reported on MFP quarterly transitions (from 4/1/13 through 6/30/13)

Actively enrolled = 58

### **Update from DAS and the ADRCs (Amy Riedesel, JW Wright and Carline Robertson)**

JW Wright reported on DAS from the MDSQ Data, SFY 2013 there were 354 referrals to MFP. Harmony database implementation is completed. Craig nursing home will be closing and DCH and DAS working with (DBHDD) to assist with transition of MFP-eligible individuals. DAS is continuing to work with DCA to build wait list for the TBRA and 811 housing programs. MFP and community living initiatives highlighted at System Integration Conference.

### **Update from DBHDD (DDD, Jenny Wiseman)**

Jenny Wiseman reported they have had a 45 day hold on transitions to make sure the quality of the transitions is good. Working to secure more homes for individuals who are transitioning out of nursing home. Wiseman mentions they have had some changes in their leadership but their focus is on quality not quantities.

### **Update from BDHDD (CBAY, Henderson-Smith)**

Dr. Henderson-Smith reported on what CBAY is which is a CMS demonstration project to demonstrate the PRTF youth can be served with intensive community based services and supports. The following MFP –CBAY Services are available: Care Management, Family Peer Support Services, Respite, Customized Goods and Services, Supported Employment, Waiver Transportation, Consultative Clinical Services, Express Clinical Services, Behavioral Assistance Services, Financial Support Services, Youth Peer Support Services and Community Transition Services.

## **Update from Housing (DCH, Jerome Greathouse)**

Jerome Greathouse reported on TBRA Program Goal and it is to provide short-term rental assistance to individuals with disabilities that are receiving services from MFP. The waiting list will open on June 1, 2013. Greathouse gave an update on the HUD 811 Demonstration Program. DCA was one of the 13 states selected through a competitive application process to participate in a new demonstration program to provide long-term project-based rental assistance to persons with disabilities.
