# Birthing Centers Programs and Services Georgia Department of Community Health

Birthing Centers are free-standing facilities where human births occur regularly.

## Exemptions:

- Licensed hospitals
- · Any birthing center operated by the federal government

### Type Regulation:

A center must first obtain a certificate of need before being eligible to become permitted.
