Please clarify.....can one county serving as the applicant be in the rural area and collaborate with other non rural counties?</p>	<p>On page iii of the Rural Health Network RFGA, Applicant Eligibility states:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicants must be a rural county with a population of 35,000 or less or defined by the state legislature.</li> <li>• A minimum two county collaboration is required and organizational eligibility may vary depending upon organizational structure.</li> </ul> <p>Eligibility requires there to be a minimum of two applicants that are both rural counties with a population of 35,000 or less or defined by the state legislature once this minimum requirement is met applicants may collaborate with non-rural or urban counties.</p>
