### Job Description

The Georgia Department of Community Health, Division of Public Health is seeking a PS Operations Analyst (SP), [Operations Analysis Mgr] in the Health Planning & Assessment Unit with the Office of Strategy and Systems Development.

Under broad supervision, completes projects and studies, including those which may have statewide impact or involve complex system problems. Determines priorities for assignments, sets goals and timetables, reviews progress and consults with staff in meeting program or project objectives. Follows existing data standards and plans, develops and/or modifies department policy and procedures, particularly with regards to public health data quality and visualization of spatial and non-spatial data. Analyzes data and continually improves current program/processes relating to the dissemination of public health data. Oversees the provision of technical assistance and provides training to organizational staff. May maintain program linkages and/or serve on major task forces.
