The Georgia Department of Community Health (DCH), Division of Public Health Office of Information Technology is seeking a **Database Administrator**.

Under general supervision, the responsibilities and activities of the employee in this position include, but are not limited to:

- Monitoring database systems to ensure the functionality of the database and the availability of system data.
- Identification of actual and potential database problems and recommends and/or implements solutions. Coordinates and controls database recovery processes.
- Performs physical modeling, database definitions and administration functions.
- Develops data models.
- Migrate database objects from test to production environments within a predefined timeframe.
- Reviews hardware and network changes and their impact to the databases.
- Reviews database access language and recommends revisions.
- Designs, codes and tests standard query language for applications.
