

# Narcotic Treatment Programs Programs and Services Georgia Department of Community Health

## **Definition:**

Any system of treatment provided for chronic heroin or opiate-like drug-dependent individuals that administers narcotic drugs under physicians' orders either for detoxification purposes or for maintenance treatment in a rehabilitative context offered by any county board of health, partnership, corporation, association, or person or groups of persons engaged in such administration.

### **Exemptions:**

Any drug abuse treatment program operated by the federal government.

# Type Regulation:

Each program must obtain a license.

# Legal Authority:

O.C.G.A. § 26-5-1 et seq.
