1	What type of program must an urban center have in order to qualify for this opportunity? It appears as if a rural-urban partnership is required in order to be eligible.	The funding is to provide access to primary care health services through a Federally Qualified Health Center. The targeted population is listed in each individual Request for Proposal. There is not a requirement for the urban center to have a certain type of program currently implemented.
2	Can the Georgia Association for Primary Health Care serve as the grantee for this announcement? The Association would submit on behalf of a group of urban and rural CHCs for each of the RFPs.	No. The RFP was structured for responses from the individual Center Health Centers (CHCs).

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3	Is this RFP for a community based face to face medical care or are you looking for education and support for your beneficiaries and to the physicians treating the beneficiaries? Would a telephonic education and interventions be considered?	The objective of this procurement is to obtain the services of a qualified firm to provide funding to expand access to primary care health services through Federally Qualified Health Centers. The goal is to increase the number of the indigent (the poor, Medicaid, PeachCare, and particularly the uninsured and underinsured) that have access to primary care services through an existing Federally Qualified Health Center at an existing or expansion location.
4	Is the contract time from June 1 2004 to June 30, 2004 (a month contract with possible renewal for a year)?	Yes, the contract is for one month with a one year renewal option.
