Job Description

The Georgia Department of Community Health, Division of Public Health is seeking candidates for the position of Geographic Systems Team Leader in our Atlanta Office.

Under general to limited supervision, uses Geographic Information Systems (GIS) technologies to meet the information needs of state Public Health programs. Completes projects and studies, including those which may have statewide impact. Determines priorities for assignments, sets goals and timetables, reviews progress and consults with staff in meeting program or project objectives. Follows existing data standards and plans, develops and/or modifies department policy and procedures, particularly with regards to public health data quality and visualization of spatial and non-spatial data. Develops and completes written and digital/interactive data, reports, charts, graphs, and maps, along with associated metadata and documentation. Identifies and implements appropriate methods for all GIS activities in accordance with current and accepted practices of the GIS discipline and community. Represents the geospatial interests of Public Health programs at technical and administrative meetings. Procures and maintains GIS software and related hardware according to the needs of Public Health programs. Provides expert GIS technical support to other Public Health program associates. Develops general knowledge of Public Health programs relative to the responsibilities of a GIS professional. Supervises GIS Team.

Qualifications

Completion of an undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university in geography, cartography, geology or a closely related field AND Two years of experience in the area of assignment
OR One year of experience at a level equivalent to the lower level (LSP062)

Preference will be give to applicants who, in addition to meeting the above requirements, possess knowledge/experience in one or more of the following:

- Proficiency with the ESRI software suite, including ArcGIS and extensions, ArcSDE, and ArcGIS Server
- Experience with Microsoft Office, particularly Access and Excel
- Experience with statistical analysis of public health data, knowledge of data standards, and data quality
- Supervisory/management experience
