Dr. Price brings more than 20 years of clinical expertise along with his experience in Medicaid and Medicare health policy, regulation and management to DCH.

Dr. Price graduated from Cornell University Medical College and completed his residency training at NY Hospital-Memorial Sloan Kettering in 1978. He is Board Certified by the American Board of Pediatrics and is a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).
