Job Description:

The Georgia Department of Community Health, Division of Emergency Preparedness and Response is seeking an individual for **EMS Training Specialist** in the State Office of EMS/Trauma – Region VI.

Under general supervision, assesses the needs of, plans, implements and coordinates training programs for Emergency Medical Technicians within a Regional EMS System. These training programs will include but not be limited to all pre-hospital and hospital personnel within a designated geographic area.

Qualifications

Completion of a bachelor's degree from a four-year college or university and two years of experience planning, delivering, developing or evaluating training/staff development programs or activities; or academic classroom instruction.

Or One year of work experience as a full-time instructor in emergency medical services topics applicable to the area of assignment which involved independently planning, developing and delivering statewide training with single or limited subject areas (e.g., emergency medical techniques) or diversified training at the district or institutional level or three years of work experience in emergency medical services, two years of which involved providing diversified training (two or more topic or subject areas) applicable to the area of assignment, in addition to regular emergency medical services duties. (note: supervisory experience is preferred.) Required licenses and eligible to obtain state instructor certification under applicable profession.

Preferred Qualifications

Two years of supervisory experience.

Two years teaching experience.

Licensed as a current Georgia Paramedic.

Moderate to advanced level of experience in use of computers (Word processing, spreadsheets, presentation software and desktop publishing.

Experience in a health care field related to the usage of data analysis which demonstrated an insight into priority health issues.

Experience in developing community, regional or statewide needs assessments, implementation strategies and evaluation tools;

Experience in developing, coordinating and managing project activities of task force
