<p><b>Regarding the cash contributions required from the collaborating partners, is cash the only acceptable form of match or can the partnering agencies purchase equipment, software, licensing agreements, etc. as their contribution to the program and use this as the cash match?</b></p>	<p><b>The Funding Requirements for this Opportunity are found on Page 19 of the RFG.</b></p> <p><b>The RFG states:</b></p> <p>Applicants are required to provide a combination of cash and in-kind funding. The cash contributions should equal or exceed the amount of grant funding requested. Cash contributions must be identified by funding source; ie, collaborating partners, area hospitals, or foundations.</p> <p>=====</p> <p>All applicants must provide evidence of another, separate source of cash contributions equal to or exceeding the amount requested from DCH.</p> <p>In-kind contributions may be made by the grantee or collaborating partners.</p>
