Analyzes specimens, interprets and records results and reports findings to designated personnel.

Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in a related science field and certification as a Medical Technologist, MT (ASCP), or equivalent certification that meets the personnel qualification requirements pertaining to "Technologists" specified in the Department of Human Resources rules for licensure of clinical laboratories.
