<p>The Department of Community Health (DCH) Medicaid Division administers the Georgia Families program, a managed care program with over 1.6 million enrolled Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids™ members. Currently, DCH contracts with three (3) Care Management Organizations (CMOs) under a full-risk, capitated arrangement to provide a comprehensive array of health care services and care coordination for Georgia Families members.</p> <p>DCH desires the opportunity to further assess the current Georgia Families program and the future programmatic solutions to address the growing Medicaid population and expenditures the State has and will continue to face over the upcoming years. At a minimum, this assessment will include opportunities to redesign or modify the program; evaluate the population(s) included in the ultimate</p>



solution; review additional covered services; and explore opportunities for enhanced administrative efficiencies. To that end, DCH requires additional time to conduct such an assessment and design the resulting solution. Further, DCH will require an appropriate implementation period. The final option for the existing CMO contracts expires on June 30, 2012. The Medicaid Division requests approval to add one (1) additional year to the existing contract with an additional (1) year renewal option. This action will provide continuity of the existing contract through June 30, 2014. The Georgia Families program is critical to DCH and to the continuity of care for our enrolled members. This request for additional options under the existing contract will help ensure the continuity of care and provision of health care services for the Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids™ members while DCH finalizes and implements the future business solution. DCH seeks your favorable consideration regarding this request.
