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Validation Overview

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requires that states, through their contracts with managed care organizations (MCOs), measure and report on performance to assess the quality and appropriateness of care and services provided to members. In accordance with the 2016 final rule as set forth in 42 CFR §438.330(c), states must require that MCOs, prepaid inpatient health plans (PIHPs), prepaid ambulatory health plans (PAHPs), and primary care case management (PCCM) entities submit performance measurement data as part of the MCOs', PIHPs', PAHPs', and PCCM entities' quality assessment and performance improvement programs. Validating performance measures is one of the mandatory external quality review (EQR) activities described in §438.358(b)(2). To comply with §438.358, the Georgia Department of Community Health (DCH) contracted with Health Services Advisory Group, Inc. (HSAG), an external quality review organization (EQRO), to conduct the validation activities. The purpose of performance measure validation is to assess the accuracy of performance measure rates reported by the MCO and to determine the extent to which performance measures calculated by the MCO follow state specifications and reporting requirements. The state, its agent that is not an MCO, or an EQRO can perform this validation.

The Georgia Department of Community Health (DCH) is responsible for administering the Medicaid program and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) in the State of Georgia. The State refers to its CHIP program as PeachCare for Kids[®]. Both programs include fee-for-service (FFS) and managed care components and deliver services through a statewide provider network. The FFS program has been in place since the inception of Medicaid in Georgia. The DCH contracts with three privately owned managed care organizations, referred to by the State as care management organizations (CMOs), to deliver services to certain categories of members enrolled in the State's Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids[®] programs. Children in state custody, children receiving adoption assistance, and certain children in the juvenile justice system are enrolled in the Georgia Families 360[°] (GF 360[°]) managed care program. The Georgia Families (GF) program, implemented in 2006, serves all other Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids[®] managed care members not enrolled in the GF 360[°] program. Approximately 1.3 million beneficiaries are enrolled in the GF program.¹

HSAG validated a set of performance measures identified by DCH that were calculated and reported by the CMOs for their GF population. The DCH identified the measurement period as calendar year (CY) 2017. HSAG conducted the validation in accordance with the CMS publication, *EQR Protocol 2: Validation of Performance Measures Reported by the MCO: A Mandatory Protocol for External Quality Review (EQR)*, Version 2.0, September 2012.²

Performance Measures Validated

HSAG validated rates for the following set of performance measures selected by DCH for validation. All performance measures but four were selected from CMS’ Core Set of Children’s Health Care Quality Measures for Medicaid and CHIP (Child Core Set)³ or Core Set of Health Care Quality Measures for Adults Enrolled in Medicaid (Adult Core Set)⁴. Three performance measures were selected from the Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS[®])⁵: *Colorectal Cancer Screening* (a non-Medicaid measure), *Lead Screening in Children*, and *Mental Health Utilization*. One measure was selected from the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality’s (AHRQ’s) Quality Indicators: *Low Birth Weight Rate*. For all performance measures, DCH identified the measurement period as CY 2017, and data were collected using the administrative methodology. Table 2 lists the performance measures that HSAG validated and the specifications the CMO was required to use for each of the measures.

*The CMO reported this measure using the *HEDIS 2018, Volume 2: Technical Specifications for Health Plans* for the commercial and Medicare populations, but applied the specifications to the Medicaid population.

In addition to the AHRQ and the CMS adult and child core set measures audited by HSAG, DCH required Peach State to report a selected set of HEDIS measures to DCH. Peach State was required to contract with a National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA)-licensed audit organization and undergo an NCQA HEDIS Compliance Audit^{TM,6}. Final audited HEDIS measure results from NCQA’s Interactive Data Submission System (IDSS) were submitted to HSAG and provided to DCH. Appendix D displays the final audited HEDIS 2018 results for all required measures, covering the CY 2017 measurement period.

Description of Validation Activities

Pre-Audit Strategy

HSAG conducted the validation activities as outlined in the CMS performance measure validation protocol. To complete the validation activities for Peach State, HSAG obtained a list of the performance measures that were selected by DCH for validation.

HSAG then prepared a document request letter that was submitted to Peach State outlining the steps in the performance measure validation process. The document request letter included a request for source code for each performance measure; a completed HEDIS 2018 Record of Administration, Data Management, and Processes (Roadmap); and any additional supporting documentation necessary to complete the audit. The letter also included a timetable for completion and instructions for submission. HSAG responded to Roadmap-related questions received directly from Peach State during the pre-on-site phase.

HSAG provided Peach State with an agenda describing all on-site visit activities and indicating the type of staff needed for each session. HSAG also conducted a pre-on-site conference call with Peach State to discuss on-site logistics and expectations, important deadlines, outstanding Roadmap documentation, and any questions from Peach State regarding the process.

Validation Team

The HSAG Performance Measure Validation Team was composed of a lead auditor and several validation team members. HSAG assembled the team based on the skills required for the validation and requirements of Peach State. Some team members, including the lead auditor, participated in the on-site meetings at Peach State; others conducted their work at HSAG’s offices. Table 3 lists the validation team members, their roles, and their skills and expertise.

Technical Methods of Data Collection and Analysis

The CMS performance measure validation protocol identifies key types of data that should be reviewed as part of the validation process. The following list describes the type of data collected and how HSAG conducted an analysis of these data:

- NCQA’s HEDIS 2018 Roadmap:** Peach State completed and submitted the required and relevant portions of its Roadmap for HSAG’s review. HSAG used responses from the Roadmap to complete the pre-on-site assessment of information systems.
- Source code (programming language) for performance measures:** CMOs that calculated the performance measures using source code were required to submit the source code used to generate each performance measure being validated. HSAG completed a line-by-line review of the supplied source code to ensure compliance with the measure specifications required by DCH. HSAG identified any areas of deviation from the specifications, evaluating the impact to the measure and assessing the degree of bias (if any). CMOs that did not use source code to generate the performance measures were required to submit documentation describing the steps taken for calculation of each of the required performance measures.
- Supporting documentation:** HSAG requested documentation that would provide reviewers with additional information to complete the validation process, including policies and procedures, file layouts, system flow diagrams, system log files, and data collection process descriptions. HSAG reviewed all supporting documentation, identifying issues or areas needing clarification for further follow-up.
- Rate Review:** Upon receiving the calculated rates from Peach State, HSAG conducted a review on the reasonableness and integrity of the rates. HSAG was unable to conduct a review that included trending with prior rates, comparison against available national benchmarks, and cross-measure checks due to a change from hybrid to administrative data collection processes for measures that were previously reported using the hybrid methodology.

On-Site Activities

HSAG conducted an on-site visit with Peach State on April 27, 2018. HSAG collected information using several methods, including interviews, system demonstrations, review of data output files, primary

source verification, observation of data processing, and review of data reports. The on-site visit activities are described as follows:

- Opening meeting:** The opening meeting included an introduction of the validation team and key Peach State staff members involved in the performance measure validation activities. The review purpose, the required documentation, basic meeting logistics, and queries to be performed were discussed.
- Evaluation of system compliance:** The evaluation included a review of the information systems, focusing on the processing of claims and encounter data, provider data, patient data, and inpatient data. Additionally, the review evaluated the processes used to collect and calculate the performance measure rates, including accurate numerator and denominator identification and algorithmic compliance (which evaluated whether rate calculations were performed correctly, all data were combined appropriately, and numerator events were counted accurately).
- Review of Roadmap and supporting documentation:** The review included processes used for collecting, storing, validating, and reporting performance measure rates. This session was designed to be interactive with key Peach State staff members so that HSAG could obtain a complete picture of all the steps taken to generate the performance measure rates. The goal of the session was to obtain a confidence level as to the degree of compliance with written documentation compared to actual processes. HSAG conducted interviews to confirm findings from the documentation review, expand or clarify outstanding issues, and ascertain that written policies and procedures were used and followed in daily practice.
- Overview of data integration and control procedures:** The overview included discussion and observation of source code logic, a review of how all data sources were combined, and a review of how the analytic file was produced for the reporting of selected performance measure rates. HSAG performed primary source verification to further validate the output files, reviewed backup documentation on data integration, and addressed data control and security procedures. HSAG also reviewed preliminary rates during this session, if available.
- Closing conference:** The closing conference included a summation of preliminary findings based on the review of the Roadmap and the on-site visit, and revisited the documentation requirements for any post-visit activities.

HSAG conducted several interviews with key Peach State staff members who were involved with performance measure reporting. Table 4 displays a list of key Peach State interviewees:

Data Integration, Data Control, and Performance Measure Documentation

There are several aspects crucial to the calculation of performance measure rates. These include data integration, data control, and documentation of performance measure rate calculations. Each of the following sections describes the validation processes used and the validation findings. For more detailed information, see Appendix A of this report.

Data Integration

Accurate data integration is essential for calculating valid performance measure rates. The steps used to combine various data sources (including claims/encounter data, eligibility data, and other administrative data) must be carefully controlled and validated. HSAG validated the data integration process used by Peach State, which included a review of file consolidations or extracts, a comparison of source data to warehouse files, data integration documentation, source code, production activity logs, and linking mechanisms. Overall, HSAG determined that the data integration processes in place at Peach State were:

- Acceptable
- Not acceptable

Data Control

Peach State's organizational infrastructure must support all necessary information systems; and its quality assurance practices and backup procedures must be sound to ensure timely and accurate processing of data, and to provide data protection in the event of a disaster. HSAG validated the data control processes Peach State used which included a review of disaster recovery procedures, data backup protocols, and related policies and procedures. Overall, HSAG determined that the data control processes in place at Peach State were:

- Acceptable
- Not acceptable

Performance Measure Documentation

Sufficient, complete documentation is necessary to support validation activities. While interviews and system demonstrations provided supplementary information, most of the validation review findings were based on documentation provided by Peach State. HSAG reviewed all related documentation, which included the completed Roadmap, job logs, computer programming code, output files, work flow diagrams, narrative descriptions of performance measure calculations, and other related documentation. Overall, HSAG determined that the documentation of performance measure rate calculations by Peach State was:

- Acceptable
- Not acceptable

Validation Results

HSAG evaluated Peach State's data systems for the processing of each data type used for reporting DCH performance measure rates. General findings are indicated below.

Medical Service Data (Claims and Encounters)

Peach State used AMISYS as its primary claims processing system. This system has been operational for several years. AMISYS captured all relevant fields for performance measure validation reporting.

During the measurement year, there were no significant changes to the system other than usual maintenance and minor upgrades, limited to provider contract and benefit maintenance. The CMO continued to capture most of its claims electronically. The few paper claims received were either for services that required additional documentation, such as medical records, or services rendered by out-of-network providers. Paper claims were submitted to Peach State's vendor for scanning. The scanning vendor then transmitted the paper claims back to Peach State in standard 837 electronic format for processing in AMISYS.

Peach State had very little manual intervention for claims processing. Most of the manual processing steps were due to high-dollar claims that required supervisor approval. As in previous audits, HSAG reviewed the coding schemes to determine if nonstandard coding was used. Peach State did not use any nonstandard coding during the measurement year.

Peach State's AMISYS system captured primary, secondary, and modifier codes appropriately. Coding updates to the AMISYS system were made annually to ensure the most recent coding schemes were captured. Most of Peach State's providers (99 percent) continued to be reimbursed on a fee-for-service (FFS) basis, which ensured that claims were submitted in a timely manner. HSAG reviewed the outstanding Incurred but Not Reported (IBNR) report and found that most claims were received within 30 days during the measurement year. Peach State's turnaround time statistics also showed that most claims were processed within 30 days.

Peach State sent medical (i.e., professional, institutional inpatient, and institutional outpatient), dental, vision, and National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) pharmacy claims in the weekly encounter file to DXC Technology, the State's Medicaid Management System (MMIS) vendor.

HSAG had no concerns with Peach State's claims and encounter data processes.

Enrollment Data

There were no changes to the enrollment process from the previous year. Peach State's enrollment data were housed in the AMISYS system, and no changes were made since the previous year's audit. Enrollment data were still received daily and monthly from the State. New members were processed and entered into AMISYS systematically. Occasionally, enrollment data were added manually upon request

by the State. Peach State's load program contained logic for cross-checking manually entered member information to avoid duplicate records. Peach State performed monthly reconciliation of enrollment data to ensure all member information was complete and accurate. Additionally, Peach State submitted enrollment files to its external vendors for processing. HSAG verified that the product and rate types which distinguish the Planning for Healthy Babies® (P4HB®) population in AMISYS were properly excluded by the CMO before the final rates were calculated.

New members were processed and entered into the AMISYS Advance system. The systematic process of enrollment at Peach State included translation and compliance validation of the 834 file and loading the data into AMISYS. The load program contained logic for matching manually entered newborn members to avoid duplicate records.

Peach State also processed enrollment changes. Enrollment changes were made primarily via the systematic loads after a change was received in the State files. Change requests submitted via telephone were updated manually by enrollment processors.

HSAG selected a sample of members from several administrative numerators and verified that the members were compliant with the measure specifications. HSAG verified age, gender, and enrollment history along with diagnosis and procedure codes. HSAG found no issues during the system review.

HSAG had no concerns with Peach State's enrollment data processes.

Provider Data

There were no changes to the provider process year over year. Peach State continued to use two systems for provider processing, Portico and AMISYS. Provider files were first loaded into Peach State's Portico system where the provider began the credentialing process. Once the provider was credentialed, the provider information was loaded into AMISYS. Peach State had a process in place for validating provider information daily to ensure both systems contained matching demographic information. Specialties were validated in Portico and then matched with AMISYS.

The two systems used by Peach State were linked by the unique provider identification number. No significant changes were made to the systems during the measurement year, other than provider maintenance.

During the on-site visit, HSAG selected behavioral health providers to validate the CMO's provider specialty mapping. HSAG requested that Peach State conduct a claims search for all provider specialties in the *Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH)* measure. The claims search found that greater than 95 percent of all claims were attributed to the proper mental health providers.

Additionally, a random provider was selected to verify specialty mapping from Portico to AMISYS to validate that the two systems maintained accurate information. The audit team had no concerns after inspecting the data as both systems matched.

AMISYS maintained all relevant information required for performance measure reporting. Both Portico and AMISYS contained unique identifiers and captured identical information as expected.

HSAG had no concerns with Peach State's provider data processing.

Supplemental Data

Peach State provided several supplemental data sources for review. Peach State only used one nonstandard data source.

The nonstandard data source, HEDIS User Interface (HUI), contained data collected throughout the year using medical record reviews. Peach State continually monitored data loaded to this source to ensure accuracy of the results. Only trained staff members were allowed to enter data into the system, and record retrieval was conducted by HEDIS trained staff. The HUI data source required primary source verification to validate accurate data capture. HSAG selected a random sample of 50 records from the HUI data source for which Peach State was required to provide proof-of-service (POS) documentation. HSAG reviewed the POS documentation, and the HUI data source was approved for use in the performance measurement calculations.

The standard supplemental data sources that Peach State provided contained laboratory, immunization, and lead screening data. The immunization and lead screening data were obtained from state-provided portals and were in standard format. Peach State provided all file layouts and captured all information in standard format. All standard data sources were provided to the CMO regularly and were directly loaded into the internal data warehouse, from which the data were later extracted into Inovalon's Quality Spectrum Insight (QSI) software.

Peach State provided supplemental data impact reports for all supplemental data sources, and HSAG had no concerns.

All standard and nonstandard supplemental data sources were approved to use for SFY 2018 performance measure rate reporting.

HSAG had no concerns with Peach State's supplemental data process.

Data Integration

Peach State's data integration process did not change from the previous year's review. Peach State continued to use Inovalon software for performance measure production but migrated to the new version of Inovalon's QSI product called QSI Excel. Peach State indicated that there were no significant issues with the migration, and no concerns were identified during on-site primary source verification.

Peach State consistently reviewed the data quality reports from QSI to ensure that all data were captured and that follow-up occurred for all data errors. Peach State had a two-step validation process that logged records submitted with the file name and record counts. Files with the same name were matched against

each other to determine if the record counts matched. The second-tier validation was conducted to determine error counts and error reasons.

Peach State conducted a full refresh of data rather than performing an incremental data load. This process captured all changes that may have occurred after the initial data were loaded.

HSAG verified that hospice members were not included in any data files. All hospice members were flagged through claims using the HEDIS code sets for hospice. This flagging was accomplished within Inovalon’s software.

Members with duplicate identifiers were mapped to a unique member identifier in AMISYS, and all claims were mapped to the new identifier, ensuring that all claims for a member were captured along with the member’s continuous enrollment segments. Peach State’s corporate team, Centene, ran monthly reports from Inovalon’s software to review data regularly. Centene frequently produced month-over-month comparison reports to ensure data were complete and accurate.

HSAG conducted primary source verification on the *Breast Cancer Screening (BCS)* and *Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH)* measures to verify accuracy for the numerators and specialty information and identified no concerns.

The *Low Birth Weight Rate (PQI-09)* measure specifications require that the rate be reported as a rate per 1,000 members. While Peach State’s calculation vendor produced the rate as a percentage, the rate reporting template provided to the CMO allowed for the capture and reporting of the rate as a rate per 1,000 members.

HSAG had no concerns with Peach State’s data integration process.

Performance Measure Specific Findings

Based on all validation activities, HSAG determined validation results for each performance measure rate. HSAG provided an audit result for each performance measure as defined in Table 5.

Table 5—Audit Results and Definitions for Performance Measures

Reportable (R)	The CMO followed the State’s specifications and produced a reportable rate or result for the measure.
Not Reportable (NR)	The calculated rate was materially biased.
Not Applicable (NA)	The CMO followed the State’s specifications, but the denominator was too small (<30) to report a valid rate.

According to the CMS protocol, the audit result for each performance measure rate is determined by the magnitude of the errors detected for the audit elements, not by the number of audit elements determined to be “Not Reportable.” It is possible for a single audit element to receive an audit result of “NR” when

the impact of the error associated with that element biased the reported performance measure rate more than 5 percentage points. Conversely, it is also possible that several audit element errors may have little impact on the reported rate, leading to an audit result of “R.”

Table 6 displays the key review findings and final audit results for Peach State for each performance measure rate. For additional information regarding performance measure rates, see Appendix C of this report.
