

## FY2020 Budget Highlights Georgia Beneficiaries of DCH Programs




93% of DCH beneficiaries are children, pregnant women, disabled, elderly, and SHBP members

#### **Child Enrollment by State**




Monthly Child Enrollment in Medicaid and CHIP: Medicaid/CHIP Child Enrollment, Apr 2020

# FY2020 Budget Highlights State Funds Expenditure by Program\*




