Kim Morris, Director, Reimbursement Financial Management presented to the Board for Final adoption the Medicaid Rate Increase for Nursing Home Mechanized Ventilator Care Programs Public Notice.

Pending Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approval with an effective date of July 1, 2020, the daily mechanical ventilator per diem will increase to \$556.77.

An opportunity for public comment was held on August 18, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., via WebEx. Written comments were accepted on or before August 25, 2020. No oral comment was received. One written comment was received.

# Written comments received:

 Donna Nackers, Vice President of Reimbursement Georgia Health Care Association (GHCA).

The commenter supports the rate increase which will assist nursing centers to address the rising cost of equipment and the provision of clinical services essential for the ventilator dependent patient population.

Pending Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approval with an effective date of January 1, 2021, DCH will add CPT code D1354-Silver Diamine Fluoride as a covered dental service.

Kim Morris, Director, Reimbursement Financial Management presented to the Board for final adoption the Primary Care Codes Rate Increase Public Notice.

Pending Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approval with an effective date of July 1, 2020, DCH will apply a 1% reimbursement rate increase for the 108 primary care codes.

An opportunity for public comment was held on August 20, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., via WebEx. Written comments were accepted on or before August 27, 2020. No oral or written comments were received.

Ms. Morris respectfully asked for the Board's favorable consideration of final adoption.

Kenneth Davis MADE a MOTION to approve for final adoption the Primary Care Codes Rate Increase Public Notice. Russ Childers SECONDED the MOTION. ON THE MOTION, the yeas were 8, nays 0, abstained 0, and the MOTION was APPROVED.

Kim Morris, Director, Reimbursement Financial Management presented to the Board for final adoption the Financial Quality Incentive for Nursing Homes Public Notice.

Pending Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approval with an effective date of July 1, 2020, DCH will apply a financial quality incentive to the nursing home per diem.

An opportunity for public comment was held on August 20, 2020 at 11:00 a.m., via WebEx. Written comments were accepted on or before August 27, 2020. One oral comment was received. Four written comments were received.

Several comments were in favor of the new Financial Quality Incentive for Nursing Homes.

DCH Response: No response.

### Written Comment:

The public notice equated The Joint Commission accreditation to American Health Care Association (AHCA) Bronze award. The written and oral comments requested that The Joint Commission accreditation be recognized at the highest award level commensurate with the AHCA Gold Award. Per comments received, AHCA Bronze award recipients must demonstrate a commitment to quality and Gold award recipients must demonstrate excellence in Quality. The commenter noted that The Joint Commission accredited nursing homes must demonstrate compliance to a comprehensive set of standards which focus on safety, process improvement and quality of care.

**DCH Response:** After review of the comments and the required compliance to become The Joint Commission accredited, DCH agrees with the commenter and will recognize The Joint Commission accreditation at the highest award level to be commensurate with the AHCA Gold Award.

#### Written Comment:

The written comment requested DCH to consider adding The Eden Registry to the current award type level.

**DCH Response:** While there are other national registries that focus on improving quality of care and quality of life in nursing homes, DCH will focus on the two quality awards listed in the public notice.

Ms. Morris respectfully asked for the Board's favorable consideration of final adoption.

Russell Crutchfield MADE a MOTION to approve for final adoption the Financial Quality Incentive for Nursing Homes Public Notice. Roger Folsom SECONDED the MOTION. ON THE MOTION, the yeas were 8, nays 0, abstained 0, and the MOTION was APPROVED.
