

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to 42 C.F.R. § 447.205, the Georgia Department of Community Health is required to give public notice of any significant proposed change in its methods and standards for setting payment rates for services.

### HOSPITAL SERVICES - SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENT FOR INPATIENT SERVICES RENDERED IN CHILD AND ADOLESCENT BEHAVIORAL HEALTH UNITS

Pending Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approval and effective July 1, 2019, the Department proposes to implement a new annual supplemental payment to acute care hospitals that have inpatient child and adolescent behavioral health units. The supplemental payment will provide additional reimbursement to eligible hospitals, bringing the total Medicaid payments for inpatient mental health services rendered by the units to the equivalent of \$750 per covered day.

This change is estimated to increase hospital expenditures for SFY 2020 as follows:

The state funds portion of this proposal was appropriated in HB 31 (SFY 2020 Budget Bill).
