The Governor's April 21st Executive Order clearly defines our Commission's goals, scope, and timeline

Our Commission is ordered:



That the Healthcare Workforce Commission shall conduct a thorough study of the state's current healthcare workforce pipeline, including, but not limited to, identifying significant data trends in healthcare workforce changes and areas of concern within the existing pipeline, and shall make recommendations for improvements to said pipeline, including, but not limited to, recommenddations regarding the expansion of education programs and clinical placements, methods to further develop and strengthen the pipeline, scholarship and loan forgiveness programs that may support workforce initiatives, investments in technology to improve workforce readiness and expand educational program capacity, and programs and strategies to improve retention and resilience of the current healthcare workforce



That the Healthcare Workforce Commission shall make a report of its findings and recommendations to the Governor no later than December 31, 2022



That the Healthcare Workforce Commission shall collaborate with the Georgia Board of Healthcare Workforce and the Office of Health Strategy and Coordination in making its findings and recommendations


