

Community Maternal Health Fair - FAQ Sheet

General Information

Q: What is the DCH Community Maternal Health Fair?

A: The Community Maternal Health Fair is an event designed to provide expecting mothers, new parents, and families with valuable information, resources, and support regarding maternal health and well-being.

Q: When and where is the health fair taking place?

A: The health fair will be held on Saturday, October 5, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., at the PARC located at 425 Pennsylvania Avenue, Savannah, GA 31404.

Q: Who is the health fair for?

A: The health fair is open to all community members, particularly expecting mothers, new parents, families, and anyone interested in maternal health.

- Health screenings (blood pressure, glucose levels, etc.)

- Educational workshops and seminars on topics such as prenatal care, nutrition, breastfeeding, and postpartum depression
- Fitness demonstrations and prenatal exercise classes
- Interactive activities for children and families
- Giveaways and raffles for infant and maternal health items such as car seats, strollers, and gift cards!
