The financial information requested on Appendix E is specific to the Proposed Use of Funds and Spending Plans outlined on page 8 of the RFGA. Only expenses related to the proposed use of funds should be included in the budget worksheet. Anticipated costs and expenditures of the identified proposal(s) are considered estimates but should reflect reasonable costs for services outlined in the proposal(s).

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
