GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION (GME) ADD-ON PAYMENTS FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE BOARDS (CSBs)

Pending Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approval and effective for services provided on or after July 1, 2019, the Department proposes to include a per claim Graduate Medical Education (GME) add-on payment to each paid claim to Community Service Boards (CSBs) with GME programs that are accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME). The total annual payment of each eligible CSB GME payment will be calculated as follows:

- (1) Determine the percentage of the CSB claims attributable to Medicaid in the previous fiscal year.
- (2) Multiply the percentage of the CSB claims attributable to Medicaid by the total GME annual expenses for the current fiscal year.
- (3) Divide the last four state fiscal years average CSB annual Medicaid claim count into the GME expenses reimbursable by Medicaid.
- (4) This payment is the per claim GME add-on payment.
