

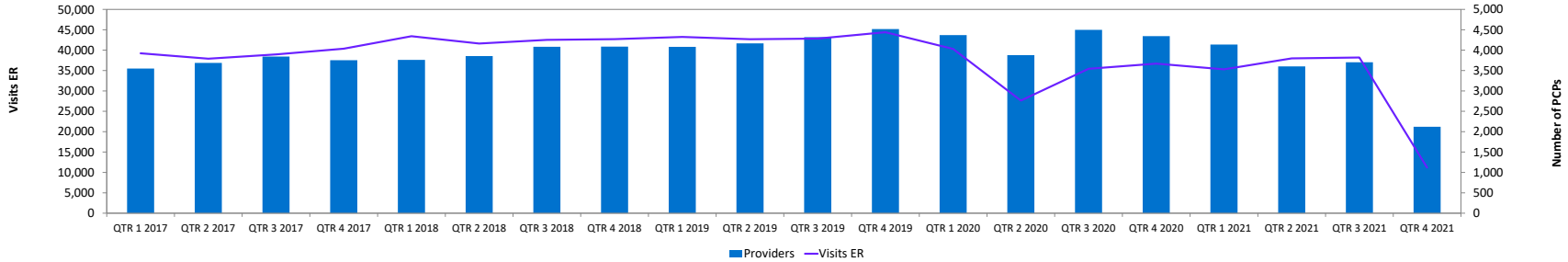

Trending of Visits ER and Number of Primary Care Physicians 2017 to 2021 by Quarter

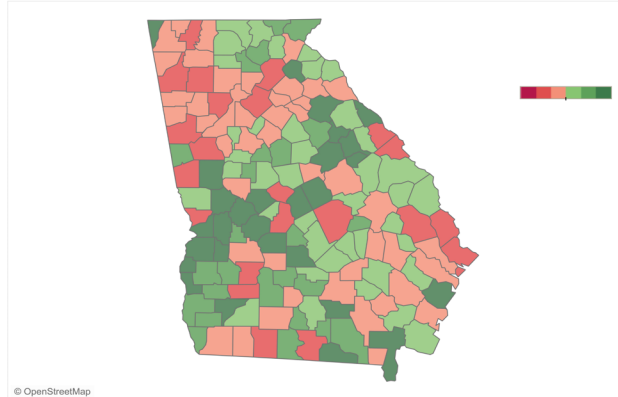

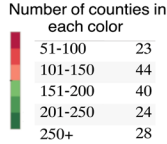

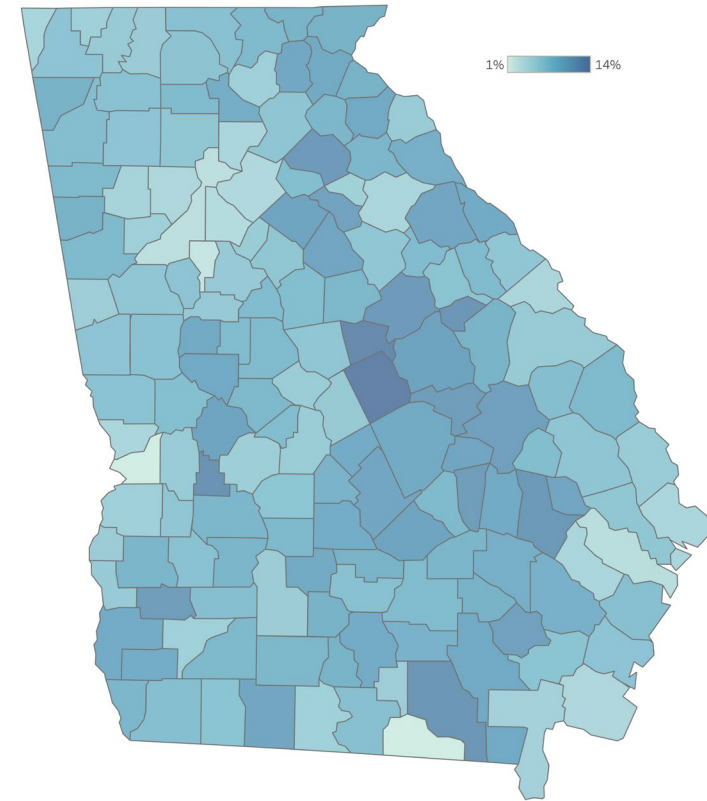

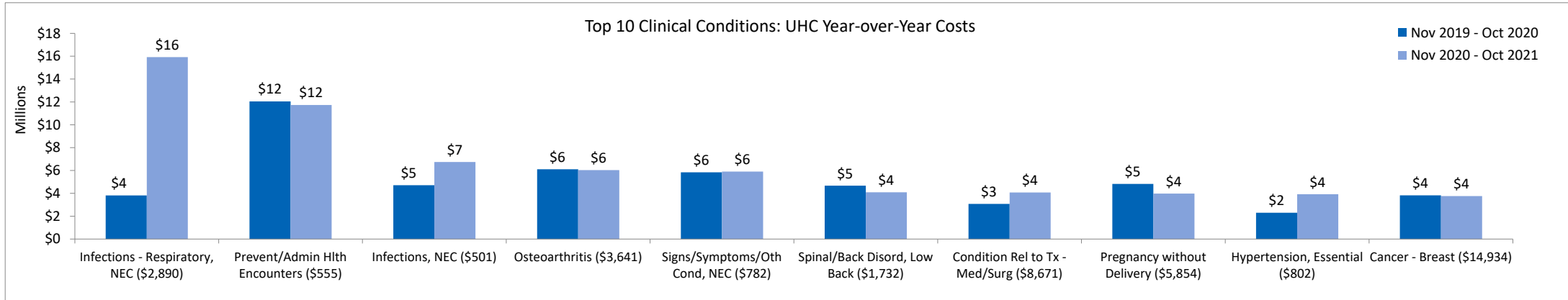

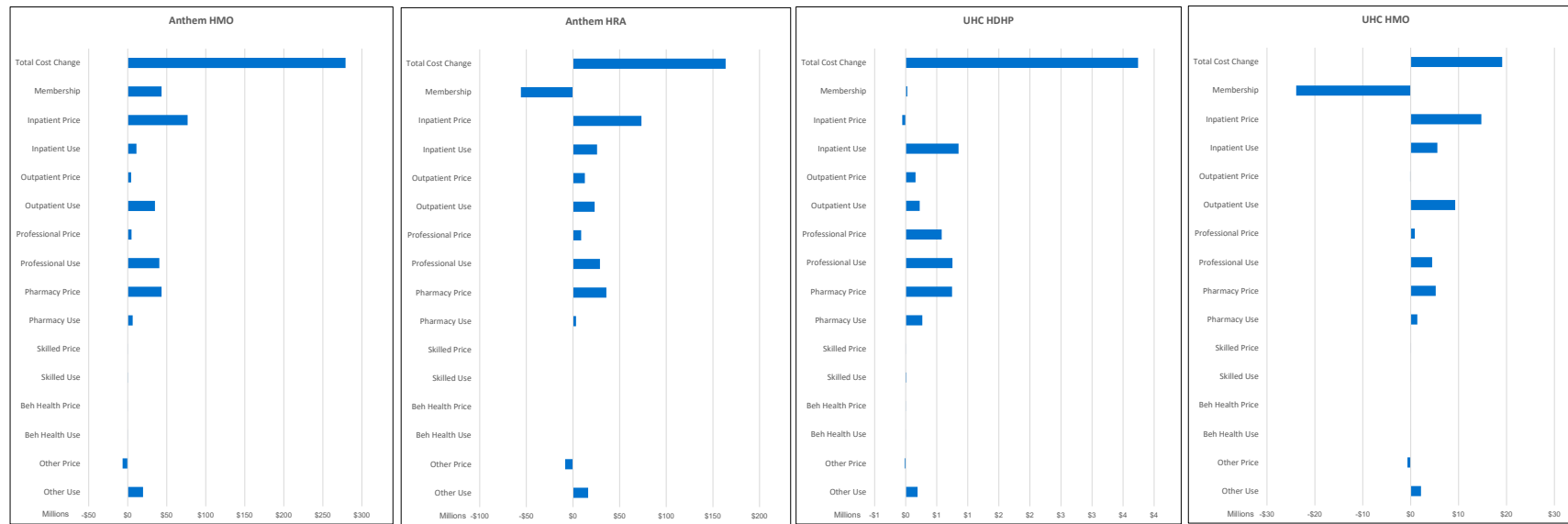
