The revised rules are being proposed pursuant to the authority granted the Department of Community Health in O.C.G.A. § 31-6-21 and O.C.G.A. § 31-6-21.1.

Board members were provided a copy of the synopsis of proposed rule changes and revised rules. During the oral presentation, the following was discussed:

- The rule revisions are necessary to comply with the provisions of House Bill 486 which changes the definition of "proxy caregiver" and requires the Department to develop a training curriculum for medication administration.
- No additional changes to the proposed rule were recommended

An opportunity for public comment was held on March 13, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. at the Department of Community Health (2 Peachtree Street, N.W., Atlanta, Georgia 30303) in the 5<sup>th</sup> Floor Board Room.
