**LENGTH OF AUTHORIZATION:** Varies

**NOTES:**

- ❖ Mozobil and Xolremdi are preferred but require prior authorization.
- ❖ If medication is being administered in a physician’s office or clinic, then the medication must be billed through the DCH physician’s injectable program and not the outpatient pharmacy program. **PA CRITERIA:**

Mozobil

- ❖ Approvable for members 18 years of age or older with a diagnosis of non-Hodgkin’s lymphoma or multiple myeloma when given in combination with filgrastim (Neupogen) prior to autologous hematopoietic stem cell (HSC) transplantation.

Xolremdi

- ❖ Approvable for members 12 years of age or older with a diagnosis of WHIM syndrome (warts, hypogammaglobulinemia, infections and myelokathexis) who have a mutation of the chemokine (C-X-C motif) receptor 4 (CXCR4) consistent with WHIM phenotypes and an absolute neutrophil count (ANC) of 400 cells/μL or less.

**EXCEPTIONS:**

- ❖ Exceptions to these conditions of coverage are considered through the prior authorization process.
- ❖ The Prior Authorization process may be initiated by calling **OptumRx at 1-866-525-5827**.
