<u>Updated Rule Variance for Fingerprint Criminal Background Checks</u> Chapter 111-8-12.05(1)(e)

Effective November 1, 2021. Effective March 3, 2022, the Department is modifying the previous variance which became effective October 1, 2020. The updated rule variance applies to Chapter 111-8-12-.05(1)(e) and is issued under the authority of the September 20, 2021, Executive Order issued by Governor Kemp and subsequent applicable Executive Orders.

<u>Implementation</u> <u>Delay</u> of Rule 111-8-12-.05(1)(e). The Department is delaying the effective date of Rule 111-8-12-.05(1)(e) from March 31, 2022, to <u>June 30, 2022</u>. Existing owners, administrators, onsite managers, directors, and direct access employees (who were in place prior to October 1, 2019) must submit a fingerprint record check application on or before <u>June 30, 2022</u>.

Please note that all facilities and providers listed herein are encouraged to submit a fingerprint record check application prior to the extended deadline date of June 30, 2022. All facilities may start the submissions of fingerprint record check application background checks immediately.
