- Verify the CMS EHR certification number for your certified EHR technology: http://healthit.hhs.gov/chpl

Step 2. Log onto the State-Level System

- Log onto the Georgia Medicaid Web Portal <u>https://www.mmis.georgia.gov</u> using your HP issued ID and password.
- Select the MAPIR link
- Select application Payment Year 2 on the "Medicaid EHR Incentive Program Participation Dashboard"
- Complete the MAPIR application.
- Upload required documentation.
- Electronically sign your application, print a copy for your records, and click the Submit button.
