

Eligible Professional Quick-Start Guide for Payment Year 2

Step 1. Before You Begin

- Go to <https://www.mmis.georgia.gov> to verify the accuracy of your GA Medicaid provider information including NPI, Social Security Number, Federal Employee ID#.
- **Download** and complete the Eligible Professional Patient Volume Calculator: <http://dch.georgia.gov/ehr>
- **Verify** the CMS EHR certification number for your certified EHR technology: <http://healthit.hhs.gov/chpl>
- **Complete** the Eligible Professional Attestation Worksheet for Stage 1: <https://www.cms.gov/Regulations-and-Guidance/Legislation/EHRIncentivePrograms/Downloads/EP-Attestation-Worksheet.pdf>

Step 2. Log onto the State-Level System

- **Log** onto the Georgia Medicaid Web Portal <https://www.mmis.georgia.gov> using your HP issued ID and password.
- **Select** the MAPIR link
- **Select** application Payment Year 2 on the "Medicaid EHR Incentive Program Participation Dashboard"
- **Complete** the MAPIR application.
- **Upload** required documentation.
- **Electronically** sign your application, print a copy for your records, and click the Submit button.
