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### **Validation of Performance Measures**

#### **Validation Overview**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requires that states, through their contracts with managed care organizations (MCOs), measure and report on performance to assess the quality and appropriateness of care and services provided to members. Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §438.350(a) requires states that contract with MCOs, prepaid inpatient health plans (PIHPs), prepaid ambulatory health plans (PAHPs), or a primary care case management (PCCM) entity to have a qualified external quality review organization (EQRO) perform an annual external quality review (EQR) that includes validation of contracted entity performance measures (42 CFR §438.358[b][1][ii]). HSAG conducted performance measure validation (PMV) for the Georgia Department of Community Health (DCH), validating the data collection and reporting processes used to calculate the performance measure rates by the MCOs (referred to by the State as care management organizations [CMOs]) in accordance with the CMS publication, *Protocol 2: Validation of Performance Measures: A Mandatory EQR-Related Activity*, October 2019. The purpose of the PMV is to assess the accuracy of performance measures reported by the MCOs and to determine the extent to which performance measures reported by the MCOs follow State specifications and reporting requirements.

The DCH is responsible for administering the Medicaid program and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) in the State of Georgia. The State refers to its CHIP program as PeachCare for Kids<sup>®</sup>. Both programs include fee-for-service (FFS) and managed care components and deliver services through a statewide provider network. The FFS program has been in place since the inception of Medicaid in Georgia. The DCH contracts with four privately owned CMOs to deliver services to certain categories of members enrolled in the State's Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids<sup>®</sup> programs. Children in state custody, children receiving adoption assistance, and certain children in the juvenile justice system are enrolled in the Georgia Families 360° (GF 360°) managed care program. The Georgia Families (GF) program, implemented in 2006, serves all other Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids<sup>®</sup> managed care members not enrolled in the GF 360° program. Approximately 1.3 million beneficiaries are enrolled in the GF program.

HSAG validated a set of performance measures identified by DCH that were calculated and reported by the CMOs for their GF population. The DCH identified the measurement period as calendar year (CY) 2021. HSAG conducted the validation in accordance with the CMS publication, *Protocol 2: Validation of Performance Measures: A Mandatory EQR-Related Activity*, October 2019.

### **Care Management Organization (CMO) Information**

Basic information about CareSource (CareSource) appears in Table 1, including the office location(s) involved in the measurement year (MY) 2021 validation of performance measures audit. The audit review activity was conducted virtually between HSAG and CareSource.

### **Performance Measures Validated**

HSAG validated rates for a set of performance measures selected by DCH for reporting of the Medicaid GF population. In addition, DCH required the CMOs to report separate rates for its PeachCare for Kids® population for a selected set of measures as indicated in the table below. All performance measures were selected from CMS' Core Set of Children's Health Care Quality Measures for Medicaid and CHIP (Child Core Set),³ and Core Set of Adult Health Care Quality Measures for Medicaid (Adult Core Set).⁴ The measurement period was identified by DCH as CY 2021 for all measures. Table 2 lists the performance measures that HSAG validated, the methodology (i.e., Administrative [Admin] or Hybrid) required by DCH for data collection, the specifications required for each measure, and the populations required for reporting.

In addition to the CMS Adult and Child Core Set measures audited by HSAG, DCH required CareSource to report a selected set of Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®)<sup>5</sup> measures to DCH. CareSource was required to contract with a National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA)-licensed audit organization and undergo an NCQA HEDIS Compliance Audit<sup>TM,6</sup>. Final audited HEDIS measure results from NCQA's Interactive Data Submission System (IDSS) were submitted to HSAG and provided to DCH. Appendix D displays the final audited HEDIS MY 2021 results for all required measures.

### **Description of Validation Activities**

### **Pre-Audit Strategy**

HSAG conducted the validation activities as outlined in the CMS performance measure validation protocol. To complete the validation activities for CareSource, HSAG obtained a list of the performance measures that were selected by DCH for validation.

HSAG then prepared a document request letter that was submitted to CareSource outlining the steps in the performance measure validation process. The document request letter included a request for source code for each performance measure, a completed MY 2021 Information Systems Capabilities Assessment Tool (ISCAT), and any additional supporting documentation necessary to complete the

audit. The letter also included an introduction to the medical record review validation (MRRV) process; a timetable for completion; and instructions for submission. HSAG responded to ISCAT-related questions received directly from CareSource during the pre-audit phase.

Approximately one month prior to the virtual audit review, HSAG provided CareSource with an agenda describing all virtual audit review activities and indicating the type of staff needed for each session. HSAG also conducted a pre-audit review conference call with CareSource to discuss review logistics and expectations, important deadlines, outstanding ISCAT documentation, and any questions from CareSource regarding the process.

#### **Validation Team**

The HSAG Performance Measure Validation Team was composed of a lead auditor and several validation team members. HSAG assembled the team based on the skills required for the validation and requirements of CareSource. Table 3 lists the validation team members, their roles, and their skills and expertise.

### Technical Methods of Data Collection and Analysis

The CMS performance measure validation protocol identifies key types of data that should be reviewed as part of the validation process. The following list describes the type of data collected and how HSAG conducted an analysis of these data:

- MY 2021 ISCAT: CareSource completed and submitted the required and relevant portions of its -ISCAT for HSAG's review. HSAG used responses from the ISCAT to complete the pre-audit assessment of information systems.
- Medical record documentation: CareSource completed the medical record section within the ISCAT. In addition, CareSource submitted the following documentation for review: medical record hybrid tools and instructions, training materials for medical record review (MRR) staff members, and



policies and procedures outlining the processes for monitoring the accuracy of the reviews performed by the review staff members.

- Source code (programming language) for performance measures: CareSource was required to submit the source code used to calculate the performance measures under review by HSAG. HSAG reviewed the source code and performance measure generation process to ensure compliance with the measure specifications required by DCH.
- **Supporting documentation:** HSAG requested documentation that would provide reviewers with additional information to complete the validation process, including policies and procedures, file layouts, system flow diagrams, system log files, and data collection process descriptions. HSAG reviewed all supporting documentation, identifying issues or areas needing clarification for further follow-up.
- Rate review: Upon receiving the calculated rates from CareSource, HSAG conducted a review on the reasonableness and integrity of the rates. The review included trending with prior year's rates and comparison of rates across all CMOs.

#### Virtual Audit Review Activities

HSAG conducted a virtual audit review with CareSource on April 12, 2022. HSAG collected information using several methods, including interviews, system demonstrations, review of data output files, primary source verification, observation of data processing, and review of data reports. The virtual audit review activities are described as follows:

- Opening meeting: The opening meeting included an introduction of the validation team and key CareSource staff members involved in the performance measure validation activities. The review purpose, the required documentation, basic meeting logistics, and queries to be performed were discussed.
- Evaluation of system compliance: The evaluation included a review of the information systems, focusing on the processing of claims and encounter data, provider data, patient data, and inpatient data. Additionally, the review evaluated the processes used to collect and calculate the performance measure rates, including accurate numerator and denominator identification and algorithmic compliance (which evaluated whether rate calculations were performed correctly, all data were combined appropriately, and numerator events were counted accurately).
- Review of ISCAT and supporting documentation: The review included processes used for collecting, storing, validating, and reporting performance measure rates. This session was designed to be interactive with key CareSource staff members so that HSAG could obtain a complete picture of all the steps taken to generate the performance measure rates. The goal of the session was to obtain a confidence level as to the degree of compliance with written documentation compared to actual processes. HSAG conducted interviews to confirm findings from the documentation review, expand or clarify outstanding issues, and ascertain that written policies and procedures were used and followed in daily practice.
- Overview of data integration and control procedures: The overview included discussion and observation of source code logic, a review of how all data sources were combined, and a review of



how the analytic file was produced for the reporting of selected performance measure rates. HSAG performed primary source verification to further validate the output files, reviewed backup documentation on data integration, and addressed data control and security procedures. HSAG also reviewed preliminary rates during this session, if available.

• Closing conference: The closing conference included a summation of preliminary findings based on the review of the ISCAT and the virtual audit review, and revisited the documentation requirements for any post-audit review activities.

HSAG conducted several interviews with key CareSource staff members who were involved with performance measure reporting.

### **Data Integration, Data Control, and Performance Measure Documentation**

There are several aspects crucial to the calculation of performance measure rates. These include data integration, data control, and documentation of performance measure rate calculations. Each of the following sections describes the validation processes used and the validation findings. For more detailed information, see Appendix A of this report.

information, see Appendix A of this report. **Data Integration** Accurate data integration is essential for calculating valid performance measure rates. The steps used to combine various data sources (including claims/encounter data, eligibility data, and other administrative data) must be carefully controlled and validated. HSAG validated the data integration process used by CareSource, which included a review of file consolidations or extracts, a comparison of source data to warehouse files, data integration documentation, source code, production activity logs, and linking mechanisms. Overall, HSAG determined that the data integration processes in place at CareSource were: Acceptable Not acceptable **Data Control** CareSource's organizational infrastructure must support all necessary information systems; and its quality assurance practices and backup procedures must be sound to ensure timely and accurate processing of data, and to provide data protection in the event of a disaster. HSAG validated the data control processes CareSource used which included a review of disaster recovery procedures, data backup protocols, and related policies and procedures. Overall, HSAG determined that the data control processes in place at CareSource were: Acceptable Not acceptable **Performance Measure Documentation** Sufficient, complete documentation is necessary to support validation activities. While interviews and system demonstrations provided supplementary information, the majority of the validation review findings were based on documentation provided by CareSource. HSAG reviewed all related documentation, which included the completed ISCAT, job logs, computer programming code, output files, workflow diagrams, narrative descriptions of performance measure calculations, and other related documentation. Overall, HSAG determined that the documentation of performance measure rate calculations by CareSource was: Acceptable

### **Validation Results**

HSAG evaluated CareSource's data systems for the processing of each data type that contributed to reporting the performance measure rates required by DCH. General findings are indicated below.

### **Medical Service Data (Claims and Encounters)**

There were no concerns with CareSource's claims and encounter system or processes. CareSource continued to use the TriZetto Facets system for claims processing and the Edifecs Encounter Management system to create the Georgia-specific Medicaid encounter data files during MY 2021.

Claims submissions were received from clearinghouses. Overall, the majority of claims received in 2021 were submitted electronically via electronic data interchange (EDI) files to CareSource's Web portal or via mail; only approximately 3 percent of claims were submitted by paper. Claims were not entered manually. All paper claims received were sent to CareSource's mailroom, scanned within 24 hours, processed through optical character recognition (OCR) software, and converted to an EDI format. EDI claims were submitted to and processed by contracted clearinghouses prior to intake and loading into Facets. Regardless of submission method, all claims were processed via Edifecs and underwent a series of validations—i.e., Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliance, claim-level validation, and business logic validation. The pre-processing edits ensured the claims contained valid codes, member information, and provider information.

Claims that passed the initial validation process were loaded to Facets for adjudication. CareSource employed Cotiviti as its pre-payment solution to evaluate payment and denial recommendations at the claim line level. CareSource also used Optum's Claims Editing System (CES) to edit both professional and facility claims and to verify claims for potential coding, reimbursement, and business rule errors. Potential errors were identified by an edit or flag, which reported back to the Facets system. CareSource conducted daily, weekly, and monthly audits to ensure claims were processed accurately. The structured combination of edits, validations, and audits enabled CareSource to auto adjudicate 94.2 percent of its claims.

During the virtual audit review, CareSource provided a demonstration of the Facets system, and HSAG reviewed the CMO's claims and encounter data processes. CareSource's Facets system captured unlimited procedure and diagnosis codes and was able to appropriately identify primary and secondary codes. CareSource only accepted standard diagnosis codes for entry into Facets, and only standard forms were accepted—professional claims (837P), institutional claims (837I), and dental claims (837D). Each claim was evaluated in a pre-production database and required to meet rigorous edit checks to ensure the claims contained complete, accurate information prior to being entered into Facets. Once the claims were loaded into Facets, additional edit checks were in place to ensure members were active and claims were valid. CareSource used an internal relational database to store all incoming data. The internal data warehouse contained both internal and external data files used for reporting. HSAG determined that the data elements necessary for performance measure reporting were captured within the system.



CareSource also demonstrated its Edifecs system during the virtual audit review, and HSAG reviewed the CMO's processes of validating, packaging, and submitting encounters to DCH. Prior to submission, claim data were put through additional validation checks based on DCH encounter requirements, including comparison to the provider registry file (7400). Then, encounter files were created in 837 format and submitted electronically on a weekly basis. Dental encounters provided by SKYGEN were ingested into Edifecs and validated before being repackaged and submitted to DCH. Pharmacy and vision encounter files were produced directly by CareSource's vendors and passed through to DCH. Encounter analysts used a variety of reports and dashboards to monitor the submission process from initial validation through receipt of response files (824 file and Georgia medical response file) and correction of errors. CareSource's encounter submissions to DCH were 99.7 percent complete.

HSAG reviewed each system and process associated with claims and encounters and had no concerns. CareSource had sufficient monitoring and oversight processes in place to ensure the accuracy and quality of claims and encounter data and had multiple edit checks throughout each point of data transfer in Facets and Edifecs. Each system captured appropriate, standard coding schemes as required for reporting.

Based on its review of ISCAT responses, audit interviews, and a virtual demonstration, HSAG confirmed that CareSource's core information systems captured appropriate, standard coding schemes as required for reporting.

#### **Enrollment Data**

HSAG had no concerns with CareSource's membership and enrollment data systems or processes. CareSource continued to use Facets for enrollment data processing. There were no significant changes to CareSource's enrollment data system or processes during the measurement year. CareSource continued to experience above average membership in its GF Medicaid population during the measurement year due to a relaxation of eligibility requirements and temporary pause in Medicaid redeterminations in response to the coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic. The increase in membership was consistent with CareSource's expectations.

The daily 834 enrollment files were received electronically from the State's enrollment broker, Gainwell Technologies (Gainwell), in addition to a full monthly reconciliation and end-of-month file. The daily file included member additions, deletions, and modifications. The enrollment data were collected and loaded into Facets on a daily basis. In addition to the unique Medicaid identification (ID) assigned by Gainwell and included in the daily/monthly 834 eligibility files, CareSource also assigned a unique member ID number to new members upon processing in Facets. CareSource used the aid codes received by the State to ensure members were appropriately assigned to specific populations, which helped ensure accurate reporting for the GF and PeachCare for Kids® populations required by the State.

CareSource reconciled its enrollment data on a daily and monthly basis. Enrollment staff members used an exceptions tool to review errors and new data not previously in Facets and correct them as needed on a daily basis. To correct discrepancies in enrollment data, CareSource sent a member reconciliation



report to DCH and received an 834 change file in response once per month. On a monthly basis, a data conflict report compared the monthly reconciliation file to the enrollment data in Facets.

During the virtual audit review, CareSource demonstrated its Facets system, and HSAG evaluated the CMO's processes for managing enrollment data. The Facets system had standardized processes for managing ID card information and newborn eligibility, and accurately tracking members across multiple lines of business.

CareSource maintained appropriate oversight of the enrollment process through ongoing internal audits and communication with the State enrollment authority. CareSource's Facets system captured all relevant fields from the State's enrollment files and continued to monitor the quality and completeness of data.

#### **Provider Data**

There were no concerns with CareSource's provider data processes; there were no significant changes to CareSource's processes from the prior year. The CMO continued to use Facets to capture provider data for claims processing. The State had a Credentials Verification Organization (CVO) that was responsible for provider credentialing for all Georgia CMOs. CareSource received daily 7400 master provider files from the State. CareSource performed appropriate reconciliation between the daily provider files received from the State and Facets.

HSAG reviewed the provider data elements in Facets during the virtual audit review and verified that the system captured key provider characteristics, including specialty and National Provider Identifier (NPI). HSAG found CareSource to be compliant with the assignment of individual provider specialties in the Facets system and the vendor software system, SS&C Health.

### Medical Record Review Validation (MRRV)

HSAG had no concerns with CareSource's MRR policies and procedures. CareSource had well-established MRR and validation processes for working with its medical record pursuit and abstraction vendor, Reveleer. Reveleer was responsible for all collection and abstraction of medical records for the *Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life* measure. Since CareSource passed the MRRV process for the prior year and its MRRV process did not change since then, CareSource was not required to undergo convenience sample validation.

CareSource used SS&C Health's CareAnalyzer software to develop its list of medical record requests for Reveleer to collect and abstract. Reveleer loaded the request list into its proprietary tool, Medical Record Collection System (MRCS), which Reveleer's nurses and staff used to fulfill the medical record collection and review process. CareSource received medical abstraction data files from Reveleer on a weekly basis and loaded the data into CareAnalyzer for incorporation into the HEDIS calculations.

HSAG confirmed that CareSource sampled according to CMS Core Set sampling guidelines. CareSource chase logic was reviewed and determined to be appropriate for the hybrid measure under



review. MRR policies and procedures indicated that clinical quality staff members and MRR abstractors underwent sufficient training. Experienced nurses at Reveleer initially overread 100 percent of exclusions and contraindications found in the MRR process, and 20 percent of all other abstractions. Then, CareSource and Reveleer jointly performed a second overread of 100 percent of all abstractions to ensure the validity of the data.

CareSource completed MRR and submitted final counts on May 6, 2022. CareSource passed the final MRRV for the *Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life* measure; individual results are presented in Table 5.

### Supplemental Data

CareSource did not use any supplemental data sources that impacted the measures under the scope of the audit; however, processes to incorporate vendor data were identified and reported in the Medical Service Data section.

### **Data Integration**

There were no concerns with CareSource's data pre-production, data integration, and reporting processes. CareSource continued to use SS&C Health's CareAnalyzer software to produce the performance measures under the scope of the audit. CareSource described its processes thoroughly and confirmed that there were no significant changes to its systems and protocols since the prior year.

SS&C Health provided the software and processed the files on behalf of CareSource. Data extracts included enrollment, provider, and claims files and were submitted to SS&C Health's CareAnalyzer using its proprietary formats. Data extracts were loaded into CareAnalyzer raw tables, and data quality reports were reviewed and approved prior to finalizing all data loads. When issues were identified, new data files would be created to correct the issues.

HSAG conducted primary source verification on the *Sealant Receipt on Permanent First Molars*, *Screening for Depression and Follow-Up Plan*, and *Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life* measures during the virtual audit review. No issues or concerns were noted during the review. HSAG reviewed members' source data to confirm the eligibility, provider specialty, and services



performed for each selected measure. All selected cases were found to be compliant with the measure specifications.

CareSource submitted final rates in June, which were benchmarked, trended, and reviewed. All measure rates were designated reportable.

### **Performance Measure Specific Findings**

Based on all validation activities, HSAG determined validation results for each performance measure rate. HSAG provided an audit result for each performance measure as defined in Table 6.

Table 6—Audit Results and Definitions for Performance Measures

Reportable (R)	Measure data were compliant with the specifications required by the state.
Do Not Report (DNR)	Measure data were materially biased.

According to the CMS protocol, the audit result for each performance measure rate is determined by the magnitude of the errors detected for the audit elements, not by the number of audit elements determined to be noncompliant based on the review findings. Consequently, an error for a single audit element may result in a designation of "DNR" because the impact of the error associated with that element biased the reported performance measure rate by more than 5 percentage points. Conversely, it is also possible that several audit element errors may have little impact on the reported rate, leading to an audit result of "R."

Table 7 displays the key review findings and final audit results for CareSource for each performance measure rate. For additional information regarding performance measure rates, see Appendix C of this report.







