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Validation of Performance Measures

Validation Overview

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requires that states, through their contracts with managed care organizations (MCOs), measure and report on performance to assess the quality and appropriateness of care and services provided to members. Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §438.350(a) requires states that contract with MCOs, prepaid inpatient health plans (PIHPs), prepaid ambulatory health plans (PAHPs), or a primary care case management (PCCM) entity to have a qualified external quality review organization (EQRO) perform an annual external quality review (EQR) that includes validation of contracted entity performance measures (42 CFR §438.358[b][1][ii]). HSAG conducted performance measure validation (PMV) for the Georgia Department of Community Health (DCH), validating the data collection and reporting processes used to calculate the performance measure rates by the MCOs (referred to by the State as care management organizations [CMOs]) in accordance with the CMS publication, *Protocol 2: Validation of Performance Measures: A Mandatory EQR-Related Activity*, October 2019. The purpose of the PMV is to assess the accuracy of performance measures reported by the MCOs and to determine the extent to which performance measures reported by the MCOs follow State specifications and reporting requirements.

The DCH is responsible for administering the Medicaid program and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) in the State of Georgia. The State refers to its CHIP program as PeachCare for Kids[®]. Both programs include fee-for-service (FFS) and managed care components and deliver services through a statewide provider network. The FFS program has been in place since the inception of Medicaid in Georgia. The DCH contracts with four privately owned CMOs to deliver services to certain categories of members enrolled in the State's Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids[®] programs. Children in state custody, children receiving adoption assistance, and certain children in the juvenile justice system are enrolled in the Georgia Families 360° (GF 360°) managed care program. The Georgia Families (GF) program, implemented in 2006, serves all other Medicaid and PeachCare for Kids[®] managed care members not enrolled in the GF 360° program. Approximately 1.3 million beneficiaries are enrolled in the GF program.

HSAG validated a set of performance measures identified by DCH that were calculated and reported by the CMOs for their GF population. The DCH identified the measurement period as calendar year (CY) 2021. HSAG conducted the validation in accordance with the CMS publication, *Protocol 2: Validation of Performance Measures: A Mandatory EQR-Related Activity*, October 2019.

Performance Measures Validated

HSAG validated rates for a set of performance measures selected by DCH for reporting of the Medicaid GF population. In addition, DCH required the CMOs to report separate rates for its PeachCare for Kids® population for a selected set of measures as indicated in the table below. All performance measures were selected from CMS' Core Set of Children's Health Care Quality Measures for Medicaid and CHIP (Child Core Set), and Core Set of Adult Health Care Quality Measures for Medicaid (Adult Core Set). The measurement period was identified by DCH as CY 2021 for all measures. Table 2 lists the performance measures that HSAG validated, the methodology (i.e., Administrative [Admin] or Hybrid) required by DCH for data collection, the specifications required for each measure, and the populations required for reporting.

In addition to the CMS Adult and Child Core Set measures audited by HSAG, DCH required Peach State to report a selected set of Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®)⁵ measures to DCH. Peach State was required to contract with a National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA)-licensed audit organization and undergo an NCQA HEDIS Compliance Audit^{TM,6}. Final audited HEDIS measure results from NCQA's Interactive Data Submission System (IDSS) were submitted to HSAG and provided to DCH. Appendix D displays the final audited HEDIS MY 2021 results for all required measures.

Description of Validation Activities

Pre-Audit Strategy

HSAG conducted the validation activities as outlined in the CMS performance measure validation protocol. To complete the validation activities for Peach State, HSAG obtained a list of the performance measures that were selected by DCH for validation.

HSAG then prepared a document request letter that was submitted to Peach State outlining the steps in the performance measure validation process. The document request letter included a request for source code for each performance measure, a completed MY 2021 Information Systems Capabilities Assessment Tool (ISCAT), and any additional supporting documentation necessary to complete the

audit. The letter also included an introduction to the medical record review validation (MRRV) process; a timetable for completion; and instructions for submission. HSAG responded to ISCAT-related questions received directly from Peach State during the pre-audit phase.

Approximately one month prior to the virtual audit review, HSAG provided Peach State with an agenda describing all virtual audit review activities and indicating the type of staff needed for each session. HSAG also conducted a pre-audit review conference call with Peach State to discuss review logistics and expectations, important deadlines, outstanding ISCAT documentation, and any questions from Peach State regarding the process.

Validation Team

The HSAG Performance Measure Validation Team was composed of a lead auditor and several validation team members. HSAG assembled the team based on the skills required for the validation and requirements of Peach State. Table 3 lists the validation team members, their roles, and their skills and expertise.

Technical Methods of Data Collection and Analysis

The CMS performance measure validation protocol identifies key types of data that should be reviewed as part of the validation process. The following list describes the type of data collected and how HSAG conducted an analysis of these data:

- MY 2021 ISCAT: Peach State completed and submitted the required and relevant portions of its -ISCAT for HSAG's review. HSAG used responses from the ISCAT to complete the pre-audit assessment of information systems.
- **Medical record documentation:** Peach State completed the medical record section within the ISCAT. In addition, Peach State submitted the following documentation for review: medical record hybrid tools and instructions, training materials for medical record review (MRR) staff members, and



policies and procedures outlining the processes for monitoring the accuracy of the reviews performed by the review staff members.

- Source code (programming language) for performance measures: Peach State was required to submit the source code used to calculate the performance measures under review by HSAG. HSAG reviewed the source code and performance measure generation process to ensure compliance with the measure specifications required by DCH.
- Supporting documentation: HSAG requested documentation that would provide reviewers with additional information to complete the validation process, including policies and procedures, file layouts, system flow diagrams, system log files, and data collection process descriptions. HSAG reviewed all supporting documentation, identifying issues or areas needing clarification for further follow-up.
- Rate review: Upon receiving the calculated rates from Peach State, HSAG conducted a review on the reasonableness and integrity of the rates. The review included trending with prior year's rates and comparison of rates across all CMOs.

Virtual Audit Review Activities

HSAG conducted a virtual audit review with Peach State on March 24, 2022. HSAG collected information using several methods, including interviews, system demonstrations, review of data output files, primary source verification, observation of data processing, and review of data reports. The virtual audit review activities are described as follows:

- Opening meeting: The opening meeting included an introduction of the validation team and key
 Peach State staff members involved in the performance measure validation activities. The review
 purpose, the required documentation, basic meeting logistics, and queries to be performed were
 discussed.
- Evaluation of system compliance: The evaluation included a review of the information systems, focusing on the processing of claims and encounter data, provider data, patient data, and inpatient data. Additionally, the review evaluated the processes used to collect and calculate the performance measure rates, including accurate numerator and denominator identification and algorithmic compliance (which evaluated whether rate calculations were performed correctly, all data were combined appropriately, and numerator events were counted accurately).
- Review of ISCAT and supporting documentation: The review included processes used for collecting, storing, validating, and reporting performance measure rates. This session was designed to be interactive with key Peach State staff members so that HSAG could obtain a complete picture of all the steps taken to generate the performance measure rates. The goal of the session was to obtain a confidence level as to the degree of compliance with written documentation compared to actual processes. HSAG conducted interviews to confirm findings from the documentation review, expand or clarify outstanding issues, and ascertain that written policies and procedures were used and followed in daily practice.
- Overview of data integration and control procedures: The overview included discussion and observation of source code logic, a review of how all data sources were combined, and a review of



how the analytic file was produced for the reporting of selected performance measure rates. HSAG performed primary source verification to further validate the output files, reviewed backup documentation on data integration, and addressed data control and security procedures. HSAG also reviewed preliminary rates during this session, if available.

• Closing conference: The closing conference included a summation of preliminary findings based on the review of the ISCAT and the virtual audit review, and revisited the documentation requirements for any post-audit review activities.

HSAG conducted several interviews with key Peach State staff members who were involved with performance measure reporting.

Data Integration, Data Control, and Performance Measure Documentation

There are several aspects crucial to the calculation of performance measure rates. These include data integration, data control, and documentation of performance measure rate calculations. Each of the following sections describes the validation processes used and the validation findings. For more detailed information, see Appendix A of this report.

information, see Appendix A of this report. **Data Integration** Accurate data integration is essential for calculating valid performance measure rates. The steps used to combine various data sources (including claims/encounter data, eligibility data, and other administrative data) must be carefully controlled and validated. HSAG validated the data integration process used by Peach State, which included a review of file consolidations or extracts, a comparison of source data to warehouse files, data integration documentation, source code, production activity logs, and linking mechanisms. Overall, HSAG determined that the data integration processes in place at Peach State were: Acceptable Not acceptable **Data Control** Peach State's organizational infrastructure must support all necessary information systems; and its quality assurance practices and backup procedures must be sound to ensure timely and accurate processing of data, and to provide data protection in the event of a disaster. HSAG validated the data control processes Peach State used which included a review of disaster recovery procedures, data backup protocols, and related policies and procedures. Overall, HSAG determined that the data control processes in place at Peach State were: Acceptable Not acceptable **Performance Measure Documentation** Sufficient, complete documentation is necessary to support validation activities. While interviews and system demonstrations provided supplementary information, the majority of the validation review findings were based on documentation provided by Peach State. HSAG reviewed all related documentation, which included the completed ISCAT, job logs, computer programming code, output files, workflow diagrams, narrative descriptions of performance measure calculations, and other related documentation. Overall, HSAG determined that the documentation of performance measure rate calculations by Peach State was: Acceptable



Validation Results

HSAG evaluated Peach State's data systems for the processing of each data type that contributed to reporting the performance measure rates required by DCH. General findings are indicated below.

Medical Service Data (Claims and Encounters)

There were no concerns with Peach State's claims and encounter system or processes. Peach State's transactional system, AMISYS, had sufficient edits in place during pre-, concurrent, and post-processing of claims and encounters. Additionally, there were no system changes or conversions implemented by the CMO in 2021.

Overall, nearly all (i.e., 98.76 percent) of the claims received in 2021 were submitted electronically via electronic data interchange (EDI) files (i.e., 97.89 percent) or direct submission via Peach State's Web portal (i.e., 0.87 percent), while only 1.29 percent of claims were submitted by paper. Paper claims were received through Peach State's corporate document management system and scanned using the MScan application in Datacap. Claims were then passed through optical character recognition software or keyed manually using Datacap to capture all data fields billed on a claim. Claims were then passed into the Centene Process Automation System (CenPAS) to be processed by claims staff members responsible for verifying claim text or keying information.

Paper claims were converted within one to two days of receipt. Paper claims that failed the process were routed to claims examiners trained on multiple markets for data entry into the system. Once entered, paper claims were transformed into standard EDI files to support downstream processing and adjudication. Electronic EDI claims were submitted to and processed by contracted clearinghouses prior to intake and loading into AMISYS. Regardless of submission method, all claims were processed and underwent a series of validations—i.e., Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliance, claim level validation, and business logic validation. Once submitted, claims were validated for compliance against the national standards, and each passed claim was loaded to AMISYS for adjudication. Peach State's auto-adjudication rate was 87.2 percent. The pre-processing edits ensured the claims contained valid codes, member information, and provider information. Market-specific business rules were applied to claims, as applicable. Claims that resulted in a pend status were routed into the appropriate work basket in CenPAS (work-flow distribution system). Pend resolution was determined by the pend code assigned and the skill level of the processor. The processor followed the appropriate workflow to analyze and finalize the claim.

Claims status was made available to providers via the secure provider portal. All claims were tracked from the point of receipt until they were loaded into AMISYS, and Peach State conducted daily, weekly, and monthly audits to ensure claims were processed accurately. In 2021, Peach State maintained a high level of financial and payment accuracy (99.23 percent). Peach State continued to have very little manual intervention for claims processing, with an auto-adjudication rate of 92.29 percent in 2021 for its Georgia market. Most of the manual steps in processing were due to high dollar claims that required supervisor approval. As in previous audits, Peach State did not use any nonstandard coding during the



measurement year. Peach State observed an increase in the volume of aged claims related to the acquisition of WellCare of Georgia (WellCare) in May 2021. In addition to the recent acquisition, Peach State experienced staffing shortages due to coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), organizational restructure, and voluntary exits, which contributed to the increase in aged claims across all categories. Peach State noted that additional staff members have been onboarded and trained to help manage the increased volume.

Peach State's AMISYS system captured primary, secondary, and modifier codes appropriately. Coding updates to the AMISYS system were made annually to ensure the most recent coding schemes were captured. All of Peach State's providers continued to be reimbursed based on an FFS payment model, although some primary care providers (PCPs) received an administrative fee.

Peach State also captured ancillary service data from external vendors, including pharmacy, dental, and vision to support performance measure reporting. Vendors submitted data to Peach State regularly, and the data were tracked and trended to ensure files were complete and accurate. Peach State received pharmacy and dental files on a weekly basis and vision files every other week. Peach State generated tracking reports for all files submitted in a given week to ensure receipt of accepted responses and mitigate any rejected files in a timely manner for processing. Adjudicated claims were submitted as encounters and received electronically, and they underwent front-end edits to assess the accuracy of incoming files and monitor the completeness of data. Additionally, the CMO conducted monthly and quarterly meetings with vendors and performed an annual audit. Peach State's oversight of this process ensured that all relevant data were captured prior to measure production.

In 2021, Peach State achieved 98.46 percent accuracy in its encounter submissions and greater than 99 percent completeness based on the latest Myers & Stauffer reconciliation report. Once claims were processed in AMISYS, extract, transform, and load (ETL) procedures were used to load data into Peach State's enterprise data warehouse (EDW). Then, based on scheduled or manual requests, ETL processes transferred data to Peach State's encounter data manager (EDM) to transform data into standard X12 transaction files and Peach State performed validation checks prior to submitting the data to DCH. No major issues were noted in submitting encounters; however, DCH/Gainwell Technologies (Gainwell) limits CMO encounter submissions not to exceed 200,000 encounters per day due to system capacity but allows for submission seven days a week. Ancillary vendor data were submitted to the encounter data team and passed through as X12 transaction files to the State. Peach State sent all required medical, dental, vision, and pharmacy encounters to the DCH/Gainwell in alignment with DCH encounter reporting requirements.

Based on review of Peach State's ISCAT responses, audit interviews, and a virtual demonstration, HSAG confirmed that core information systems captured appropriate, standard coding schemes as required for reporting.

Enrollment Data

There were no concerns with Peach State's membership and enrollment data systems or processes. Peach State's enrollment system, the Unified Member View (UMV), a component system of the AMISYS



transactional system, was used as the system of record for enrollment and eligibility information. No system changes or conversions were implemented by the CMO in 2021. Peach State experienced an increase of nearly 50 percent in its Georgia Families Medicaid population between January and December due to the acquisition of WellCare in 2020. At a local level, Peach State and WellCare began functioning as one entity on May 1, 2021. This acquisition led to an increase of approximately 400,000 Medicaid members under Peach State's care. In addition, the continued hold on eligibility redetermination as a result of the COVID-19 public health emergency remains a key driver to increased membership volume. Membership trends were reviewed and discussed during the audit and were consistent with expectations.

The daily 834 enrollment files were received electronically from the State's enrollment broker, Gainwell, in addition to a full monthly reconciliation and end-of-month file. The daily files included member additions, deletions, and modifications. The CMO checked the files for compliance, and reconciliation reports were produced to ensure the completeness and accuracy of transmission. Following initial validation checks, Peach State transformed the daily and monthly EDI files for loading into UMV and performed a series of validation and quality checks on the incoming data. The CMO also checked the files for compliance, and reconciliation reports were produced to compare file counts received from the State versus loaded into the system. Any identified errors were researched, and corrections were made directly in UMV. Peach State performed monthly reconciliation of enrollment data to ensure all member information was complete and accurate. Additionally, Peach State submitted enrollment files to its external vendors for processing. UMV continued to maintain all enrollment data for MY 2021. Once processed in UMV, enrollment data were loaded into AMISYS. Peach State also transmitted enrollment data to downstream vendors and delegated entities on a timely basis to support member services.

In addition to the unique Medicaid identification (ID) assigned by Gainwell and included in daily/monthly 834 EDI files, Peach State also assigned a unique member ID number to new members upon processing in UMV. Members whose information was previously entered into UMV had the information updated to avoid duplicate entries.

Peach State conducted appropriate oversight of the enrollment process through ongoing internal audits and communication with the State enrollment authority. Peach State's UMV and AMISYS systems captured all relevant fields from the State's enrollment files and continued to monitor the quality and completeness of data.

Provider Data

There were no concerns with Peach State's provider data systems or processes. Peach State's provider system, Portico, was used to process and store key provider demographic information and supported provider enrollment and contracting processes, including the capture of key provider data elements—i.e., board certification and specialties, affiliation, and contract details. Provider information was extracted from Portico and loaded to AMISYS through scheduled ETL processes nightly. While data in both systems were linked by a unique provider identification number, the flow of provider data was one-way from Portico to AMISYS. Reconciliation of provider data between the systems was based on



weekly discrepancy reports which were "worked" to ensure equivalence between the two systems. Peach State used CenProv as a tool to receive provider updates (i.e., new provider enrollment, terminations, contact information, etc.). CenProv generates tickets based on type, ID, and category, and are assigned to designated provider staff to update Portico with information received through CenProv. Peach State conducts routine audits to ensure provider changes received through CenProv are timely and accurately updated in Portico.

Peach State demonstrated the CenProv, Portico, and AMISYS provider systems during the virtual audit review, and HSAG verified that all systems accurately captured key provider characteristics, including specialty.

Medical Record Review Validation (MRRV)

There were no concerns with Peach State's MRR policies and procedures. Peach State had well-established MRR processes and qualified internal staff performing MRR abstraction under experienced supervision. HSAG notified Peach State on February 16, 2022, that Peach State was exempt from convenience sample validation for the one hybrid measure, *Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life*.

HSAG confirmed that Peach State sampled according to CMS Core Set sampling guidelines. Peach State's chase logic was reviewed and determined to be appropriate for the hybrid measure. MRR policies and procedures indicated that clinical quality staff members and MRR abstractors underwent annual training, and abstractions were regularly overread by experienced nurses.

Similar to past years, the CMO contracted with Change Healthcare to support chase, procurement, and abstraction activities, while internal staff members conducted quality assurance oversight in MY 2021. All qualified staff members were trained in the *Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life* CMS Core Set specifications and in the use of Change Healthcare's Chart Abstraction Operations (CAO) tool used in conjunction with Inovalon's abstraction tool (i.e., Quality Spectrum Hybrid Reporter [QSHR]) to manage and accurately conduct MRR and oversight. HSAG's clinical team reviewed Change Healthcare's hybrid tool and participated in a live demonstration of the MRR application to determine compliance with audit standards. HSAG approved the tool for use in MY 2021.

Peach State completed MRR and submitted final counts on May 6, 2022. Peach State passed the final MRRV for the *Developmental Screening in the First Three Years of Life* measure; individual results are presented in Table 5.

Supplemental Data

Supplemental data validation was not under the scope of the PMV audit. However, processes to incorporate vendor data were identified and reported in the Medical Service Data section.

Data Integration

There were no concerns with Peach State's data pre-production, data integration, and reporting processes. Peach State continued to use Inovalon software, Quality Spectrum Insight (QSI®-XL) for performance measure production. Peach State described its processes thoroughly and confirmed that there were no significant changes to its systems and protocols since the prior year.

AMISYS continued to serve as the source of data for the EDW used to support measure production and reporting. Peach State used SQL Server Integration Services (SSIS) packages to extract data from the EDW via ETL processes to staging tables where data were transformed into QSI-XL proprietary layouts. Validation reports were generated to ensure file format and size, record counts, and field transformations were compliant with requirements. In case of any issues in the loading process, notifications were sent to the responsible business users for examination. Peach State also had a robust quality control process in place to track the data load process for all sources. Once validated, data were zipped and uploaded into QSI-XL. Peach State provided a thorough explanation of the data flow process within its systems.

Peach State continued to contract with Inovalon to support the calculation of the non-HEDIS, CMS Core Set measures within the scope of HSAG's audit. Inovalon was responsible for maintaining all aspects of the QSI-XL application. Peach State consistently reviewed the data quality reports from QSI-XL to ensure all data were captured and that the CMO followed up on all data errors. Peach State had a two-step validation process that logged records submitted with the file name and record counts. Files with the same name were matched against each other to determine if the record counts matched. The second-tier validation was conducted to determine error counts and error reasons. In coordination with Peach State and Inovalon, HSAG coordinated a virtual review of all source code used to generate the performance measures. HSAG evaluated the code to ensure compliance with the measure specifications required by the State; all source code was approved. Peach State conducted a full refresh of data rather than incremental data loads to ensure all changes were captured. Peach State's corporate team, Centene, ran monthly reports from Inovalon's software to review data regularly. Centene frequently produced month-over-month comparison reports to ensure data were complete and accurate.

During the virtual audit review, HSAG performed PSV on the following measures— CDF, DEV, and SFM. HSAG reviewed members' source data to confirm the eligibility, provider specialty, and services performed (at least five records per measure) for each selected measure. Additional follow-up was



required after the virtual audit review, and Peach State uploaded additional documentation to support the inclusion of selected PSV cases. All documentation and screenshots demonstrated compliance.

Peach State submitted final rates in June 2022, which were benchmarked, trended, and reviewed. Follow-up was conducted and questions were successfully resolved. All measure rates were designated reportable.

Performance Measure Specific Findings

Based on all validation activities, HSAG determined validation results for each performance measure rate. HSAG provided an audit result for each performance measure as defined in Table 6.

According to the CMS protocol, the audit result for each performance measure rate is determined by the magnitude of the errors detected for the audit elements, not by the number of audit elements determined to be noncompliant based on the review findings. Consequently, an error for a single audit element may result in a designation of "DNR" because the impact of the error associated with that element biased the reported performance measure rate by more than 5 percentage points. Conversely, it is also possible that several audit element errors may have little impact on the reported rate, leading to an audit result of "R."

Table 7 displays the key review findings and final audit results for Peach State for each performance measure rate. For additional information regarding performance measure rates, see Appendix C of this report.
