- Healthcare Facility Regulation Related Legislation
 - HB 249 (Controlled substances; collect more information regarding dispensing and use; provisions)
 - HB 486 (Georgia Registered Professional Nurse Practice Act; training of proxy caregivers; provisions)



- Healthcare Facility Regulation Related Legislation cont.
 - SB 88 (Narcotic Treatment Programs Enforcement Act)
 - SB 96 (Health; pronouncement of death by registered professional nurses; nursing homes and hospice care; authorize; county medical examiner's duties after notice of suspicious death; make a conforming change)



Medicaid Related Legislation

- HB 154 (Dental hygienists; perform certain functions under general supervision; authorize)
- HB 206 (Pharmacy Audit Bill of Rights)



- Medicaid Related Legislation cont.
 - SB 70 (Hospital Medicaid Financing Program; sunset provision; extend)
 - SR 188 (Senate Study Committee on Barriers to Georgians' Access to Adequate Healthcare)



- State Office of Rural Health Related Legislation
 - SB 14 (State Income Taxes; rural hospitals income tax credit; clarify the amount of an exemption for certain entities under the contributions)



Next Steps

- Continue conducting a legal and programmatic analysis to determine the full impact of the legislation
- Develop and rollout any policy and practice changes to meet new requirements (pending Governor signature)
