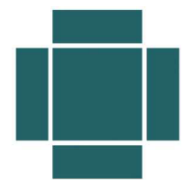


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# 2016 Jasper Memorial Hospital Community Health Needs Assessment and Implementation Plan

- ▶ The second leading cause of death in Jasper County is due to mental and behavioral health disorders.
- ▶ Suicide is the third leading cause of premature death in Jasper County.
- ▶ The Jasper County death rate for suicide is 57% higher than the state and the majority of suicides occur in the population 65 years and younger.
- ▶ The Department of Health and Human Resources has named Jasper County as a Health Professional Shortage area for mental health providers.

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# Jasper Memorial Hospital has Collaborated with Jasper County Charter System

- ▶ Jasper Memorial Hospital allocated \$40,710.00 of grant funds to Jasper County Charter System for student therapy services, which began January, 2018.
  - ▶ This allowed the school system to increase access to clinical counseling.
  - ▶ Transformation Therapy is the clinical counseling group and they continue to support students in school to decrease crisis situations and increase time in class.



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## Jasper Memorial Hospital has Collaborated with Jasper County Charter System

### Goals:

- ▶ Decrease number of crisis episodes - providing students with the skills necessary to manage and cope during times of crises.
- ▶ Improve overall attendance of students receiving services
- ▶ Improve achievement scores



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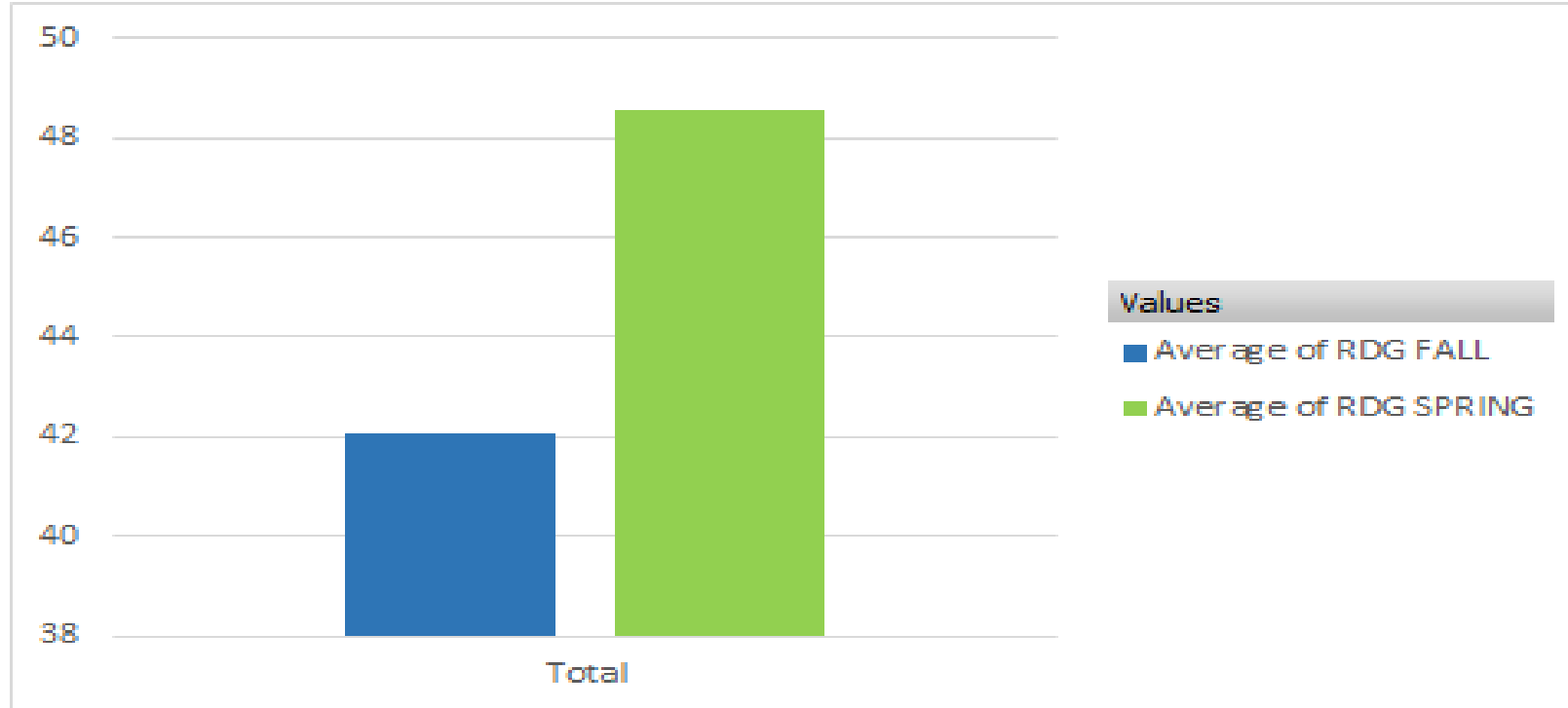
# Absences (students receiving services)



- There has been a 72% reduction in absences in students receiving services since December 2017.
- Influx in January was influenced by seasonal illness (influenza)
- Students that were absent 5-8 days in December, were only absent 0-1 day in May.



# Student Achievement Reading

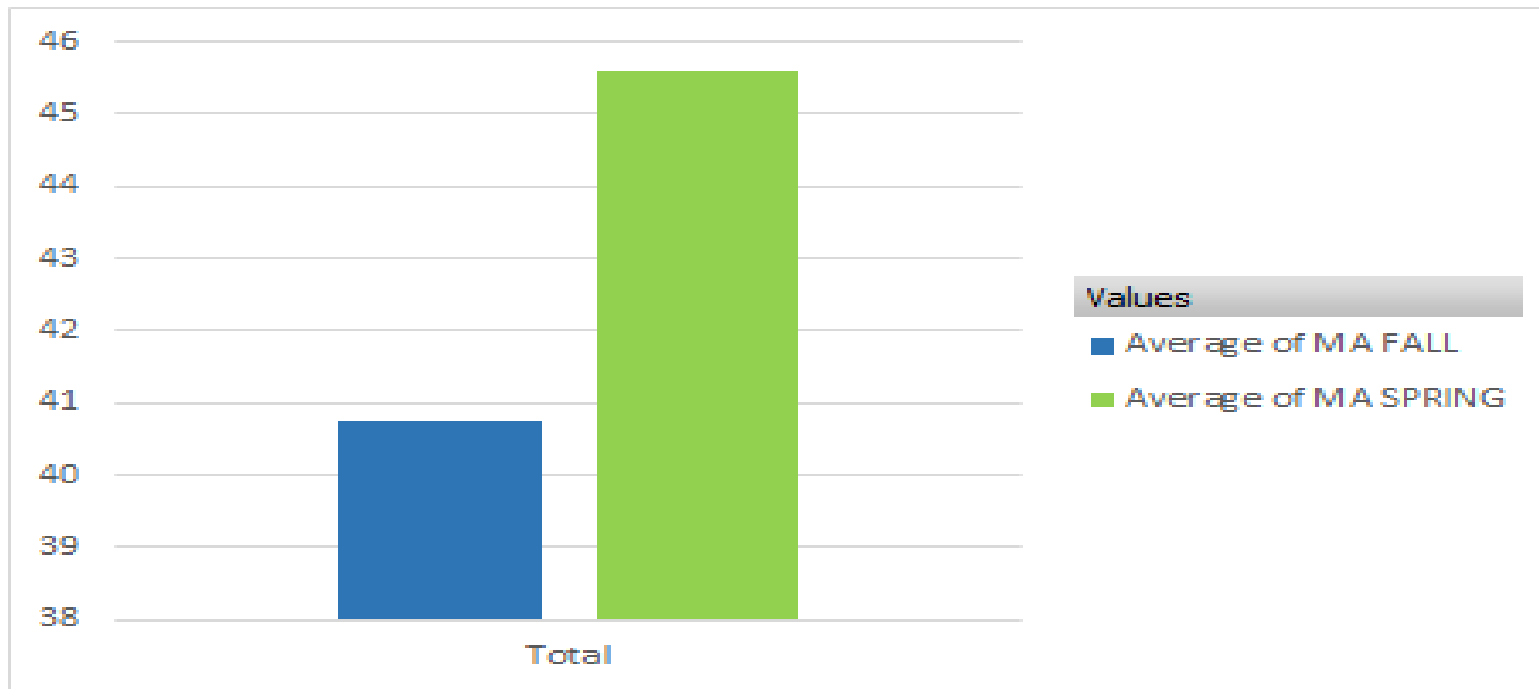


- Average of 6+ point increase in Reading scores from Fall to Spring administration of MAP test



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# Student Achievement (Math)

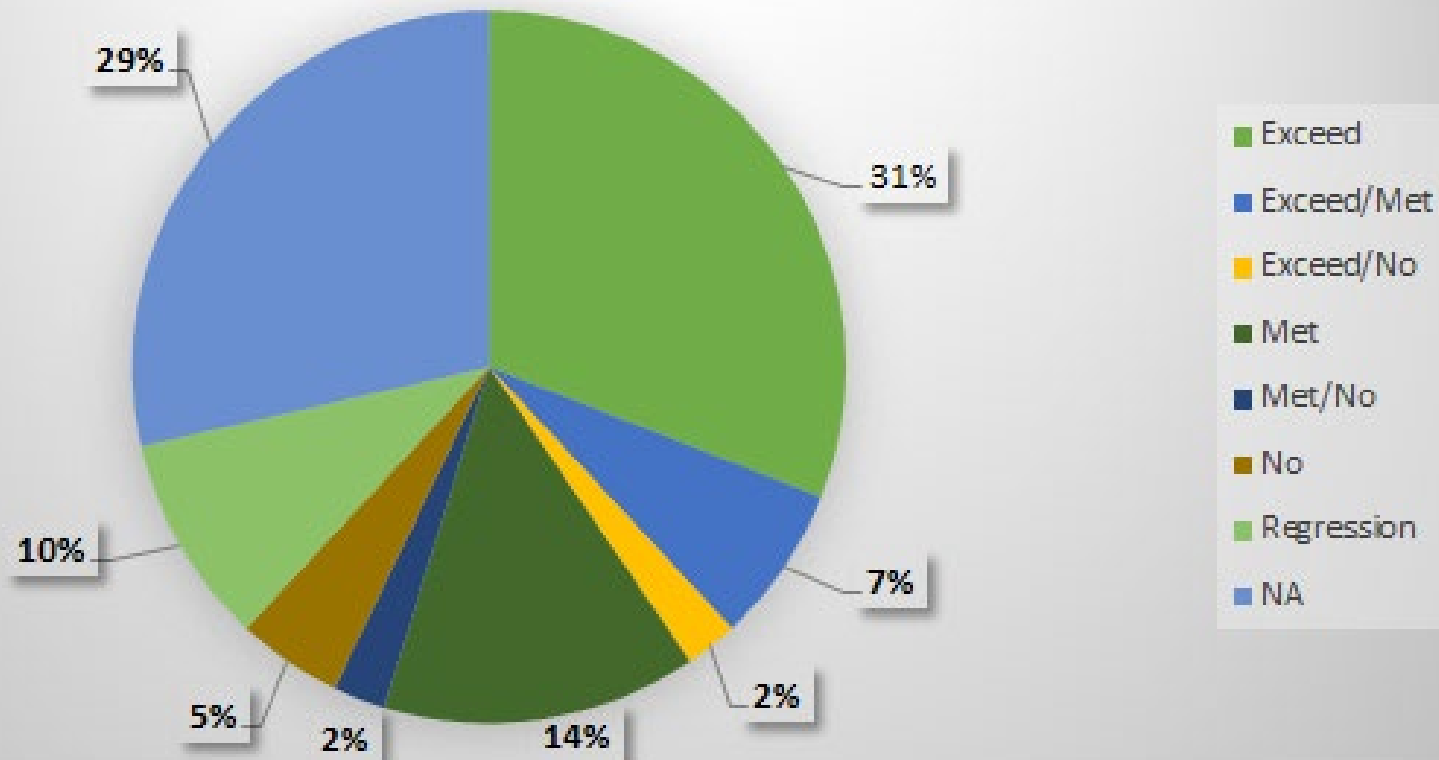


Average of 5 point increase in Math scores from Fall to Spring administration of MAP test



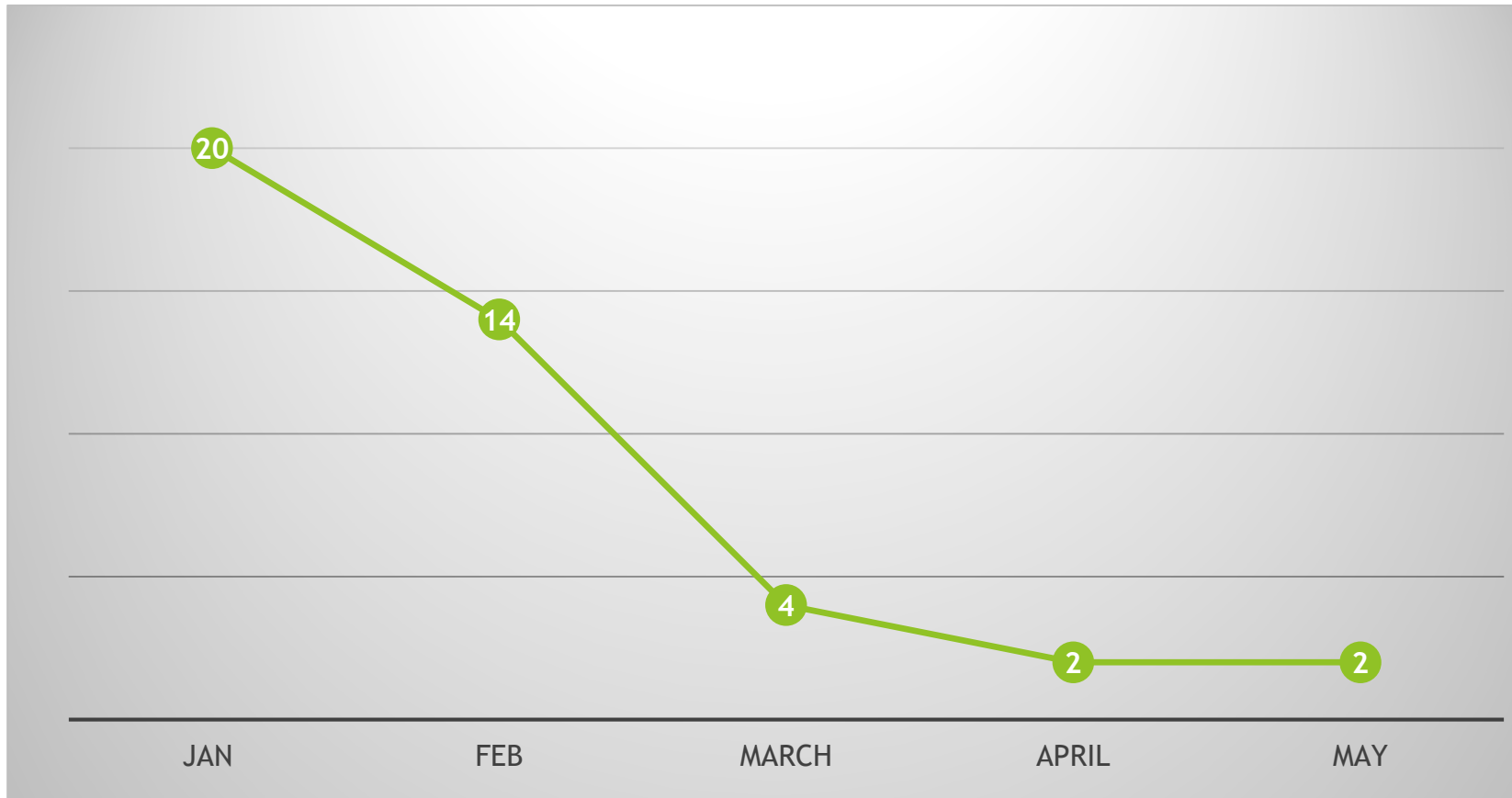
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## Student Growth
