


Target Population Breakout

■ DD ■ PD/TBI ■ OA






Dashboard Highlights


- Cumulative from January 2010 to March 2014
 - Y1 trends remain consistent with previous quarter
 - Y2 trend variations have occurred
 - M3Q15: DD have a positive post transition change
 - M7Q39: OA have a negative post transition change

- Cumulative QoL Surveys (as of 5.31.14)

Completed	606	361	967
Lost (Deceased or Moved)	96	41	137
Refused	61	35	96
Total	763	437	1200

Year in Review

	Year-One	Year-Two
Cumulative Cooperation Rate	79%	83%
Cumulative Response Rate	63%	61%

Year in Review

- Identified questions and challenges and addressed them
 - Locating participants
 - Receive additional information from DBHDD/DAS data systems
 - High rates of proxy responses
 - Analysis of QoL data by respondent type
 - More in-person interviews
 - Proportion of individuals moving to group/personal care homes
 - Analysis of QoL data by housing type

Do the people who help you listen carefully to what you ask them to do?
Have you been happy or unhappy with the way you live your life?
*How would you rate your health?

Being a proxy (baseline, year 1, year 2)	
Being a proxy responding for a participant with a DD (year 1)	
*Being a service provider proxy responding for a participant with a DD (Listening only) (year 1)	

Housing Analysis Summary

**Do you like where you live?
Have you been happy or unhappy with the way you live your life?**

Significant Association	No Significant Association
Not living in a group home or nursing facility (baseline only)	A participant living on his/her own (year 1)
	A participant living with family or friends (year 1)
