PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to 42 C.F.R. § 447.205, the Georgia Department of Community Health is required to give public notice of any significant proposed change in its methods and standards for setting payment rates for services.

MEDICAID ACCESS MONITORING REVIEW PLAN (AMRP) IMPLEMENTATION

42 U.S.C. §1396a(a)(30)(A) requires the State to ensure that provider payments allow FFS beneficiaries to access care in a manner equal to that of the general population in their geographic region.

This purpose of the Plan is to outline Georgia Medicaid's proposed plan for measuring and monitoring fee-for-service (FFS) beneficiaries' overall distance as measured with actual driving routes, not radially, between their residence and the following provider locations. Georgia Medicaid is committed to ensuring its FFS beneficiary group has proper access to adequate provider networks.

Medicaid will monitor eight different provider groups as part of this review plan:

- Primary Care Providers (PCPs)
- Specialists
- General and Subspecialty Dental Providers
- Home Health Services
- Hospitals
- Mental and Behavioral Health Providers
- Pharmacies
- OB/GYNs
