

## PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to 42 C.F.R. §447.205, the Georgia Department of Community Health is required to give public notice of any significant proposed change in its methods and standards for setting payment rates for services.

### Comprehensive Supports Waiver Program (COMP) Rate Increase and New Services

Effective with an approved amendment by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services for the COMP Waiver Program and subject to payment at fee-for-service rates, the Department, in response to a joint federal and state initiative to increase access to care, is proposing an increase in rates of select services. The Department is proposing to make the following changes to Medicaid reimbursement for specific services provided through the COMP Waiver Program:

1. Increase the current rates of the following services by 2%:
  - a. Community Access Services (both Group and Individual)
  - b. Prevocational Services
  - c. Supported Employment Services (both Group and Individual)
  - d. Community Residential Alternative Services
  - e. Community Living Supports (both the 15-minute unit and the daily rates)
  - f. Support Coordination
2. Establish rates for two new services:
  - a. Behavioral Supports Services which will provide additional support for individuals with challenging behaviors through onsite intervention and training for paraprofessional staff and family members. The proposed rate is \$18.75/unit following rates for similar services in other programs.
  - b. Intensive Support Coordination which will be used to provide oversight and intensive monitoring of individuals transitioning from institutions and those with complex medical and/or behavioral needs. Clinical teams with expertise in specific risk areas will provide this service under a proposed rate of \$461.00 per month.
3. Remove Skilled Nursing Services from its current rate methodology linked to the provision of community residential or home-based community living supports services. Skilled Nursing Services will be billed under established nursing services rates under the waiver as a separate, stand-alone service.
