
What is GCHEXS?

In section 6201 of the Affordable Care Act, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) established the National Background Check Program (NBCP) to improve the health and safety of long-term care residents and their families by establishing a nationwide program for screening applicants seeking employment with Long Term Care facilities and providers.

Georgia Criminal History Check System (GCHEXS) Highlights

- First DCH/IA meeting was May 20, 2015
- Went live on February 1, 2016
- Average length of time for a determination is ONE DAY!
- Completed Determinations
 - 98.5% are Satisfactory
 - 1.5% are Unsatisfactory
